Award Conditional Funding (Loans) for \$16 Million in Housing Mitigation Funds and Below Market Rate In-Lieu Funds for the Pre-development, Development and/or Rehabilitation of Four Affordable Housing Developments

SUMMARY OF COMMISSION ACTION

The Housing and Human Services Commission (HHSC) considered this item on September 21, 2022 (Attachment 1).

The Housing and Human Services Commission voted to approve Alternative 1: Recommend that Council award conditional funding commitments for \$16 million in Housing Mitigation Funds and Below Market Rate In-lieu Funds for the pre-development, development and/or rehabilitation to the projects listed in Attachment 3 to the report. The vote was 5-0, with Commissioner Stetson absent.
