Native Plant Initiative

Working to remove invasive species

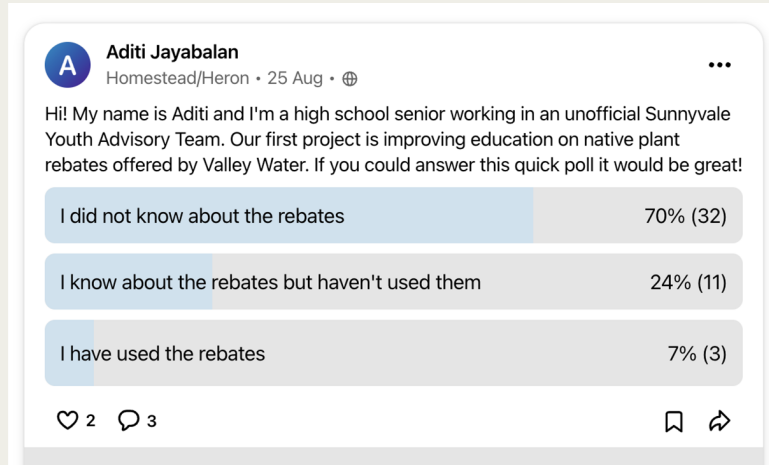
1. Converted previous areas at Fremont High School to from invasive → native
2. Worked with FUHSD gardeners to develop budget, list of plants
3. Worked with Valley Water Youth commission to receive \$200 grant
4. Coordinated with district for bamboo removal

5. Collaborated with clubs for volunteers

6. Developing a “handbook” of steps for other schools to follow the process we took



7. Created and presented assessment of Valley Water rebate programs



- Rebates may not be appealing enough or well-reached
