TDA Article 3 Funding for FY 2025/26

- **Total - \$811,845**
 - ◆ Banked from FY 2024/25 - \$411,038
 - ◆ Rescission from previous completed projects - \$210,475
 - ◆ Current Year Allocation - \$190,333

Newly Added Potential Project: Improvements to Bike/Pedestrian Bridges and Paths

Description

- Borregas Bridge over US 101 and SR 237
 - ◆ Remove bollards at all entrances

Staff Comments

- Installed in early 2010s per BPAC's request to deter bicyclists from riding at high speeds
- Staff can evaluate relocating signs & installing pavement markings
- Modifications can be done with existing operating budget

3	Evelyn Ave Multi-Use Trail	Construct multi-use trail on the north side of Evelyn Ave from Mountain View/ Sunnyvale city limits to Mathilda Place	\$300,000	Eligible – Y Recommended – Y
4	SRTS Improvements at Gail Ave/Iris Ave	Curb extension, high visibility crosswalks, green stormwater infrastructure	\$225,000	Eligible – Y Recommended – Y
5	Reduce pork chop islands on El Camino Real	- WB ECR at Murphy Ave - WB ECR at Frances St	\$70,000	Eligible – Y Recommended – N
6	Convert remaining part-time bike lanes on Homestead Rd into full-time bike lane	Remove/replace and install new signs/ poles & align with 2026 Slurry Seal project	\$60,000	Eligible – Y Recommended – N
