Context:

The referenced house was burglarized Friday January 22, 2016 between 11:30 AM and 1:30 PM. (Police Report case: CR16-509)

As all the doors were locked, including the two side gates, the buglar(s) escalated and jumped above the right side gate.

Project details:

The purpose of this project is to raise the height of 2 gates and the part of one side fence, facing the open area in order to make escalation more difficult and improve security.

The heigh increase will be one foot of lattice added to the existing structures (gates and fence). The horizontal total length of raised structures will be 28 feet split on 2 sides
