
Training

- Intergroup Dialogue (IGD):




HRC Activities 2023

Wordly Pilot Evaluation

- Wordly Pilot Evaluation
- Benefits: Real-time translation in 50+ languages, improved meeting flow, enhanced understanding
- Usage:
 - Cost: \$15,000 for 100 hours (budgeted)
 - Total Usage: 67.85 hours (\$7,633)
 - HRC Usage: 28.33 hours (\$3,187)
- **Additional Considerations:**
 - Staff training and time to manage Wordly effectively

 - Challenges: Glitches, inaccuracies, technical issues



Enhancement Strategy

- Address technical issues with Wordly
- Enhance translation accuracy
- Create a feedback loop
- Explore supplementary tools, including human translators for comparison
- Continue to train City staff on its use; expand use as we refine functionality and as staff capacity permits.
