- Work to be completed by November 15th



- Not expected to be done in time for this CWSP.



Updated Responses to Issues/Concerns: Exterior Lighting, Vegetation Removal, Addressing Unauthorized Camping

- Sandis' work with the City will cover the exterior lighting as related to pedestrian access.
- Lighting on the building toward the parking lot will be added.
- Sandis' communication with CalTrans will include appropriate vegetation removal.
- Staff outreach workers will monitor adjacent neighborhood to ensure safety of clients and community members and prevent loitering.
- If unauthorized camping is discovered in the neighborhood, staff will try to connect the individuals to services and address all issues appropriately, including contacting Dept. of Public Safety for assistance.

Preparation for Alternate Emergency Shelter

- Location: interior warehouse side of the building
- Preparatory work being done:
 - Electrical work
 - Heating + lighting
 - Location of food service area
 - Fire alarm + fire sprinklers (existing is sufficient)
 - Portable showers and restrooms
- Program staffing, janitorial service and supplies are in the process of being secured.
- Same Operational Plan will be implemented.
