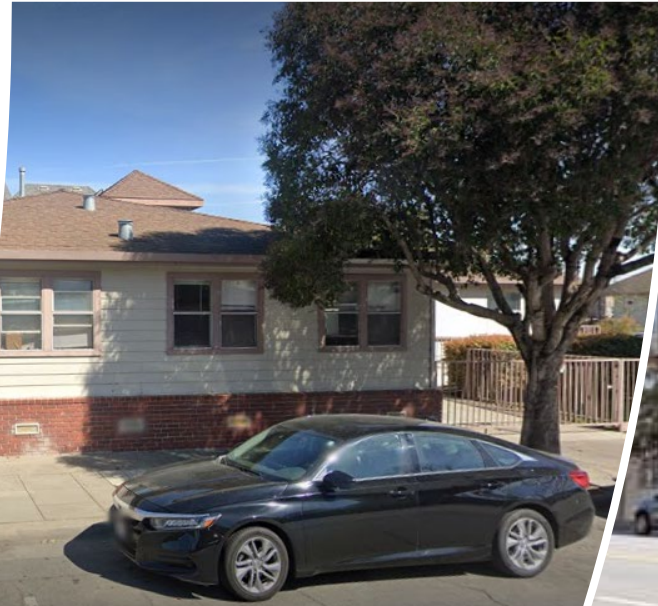

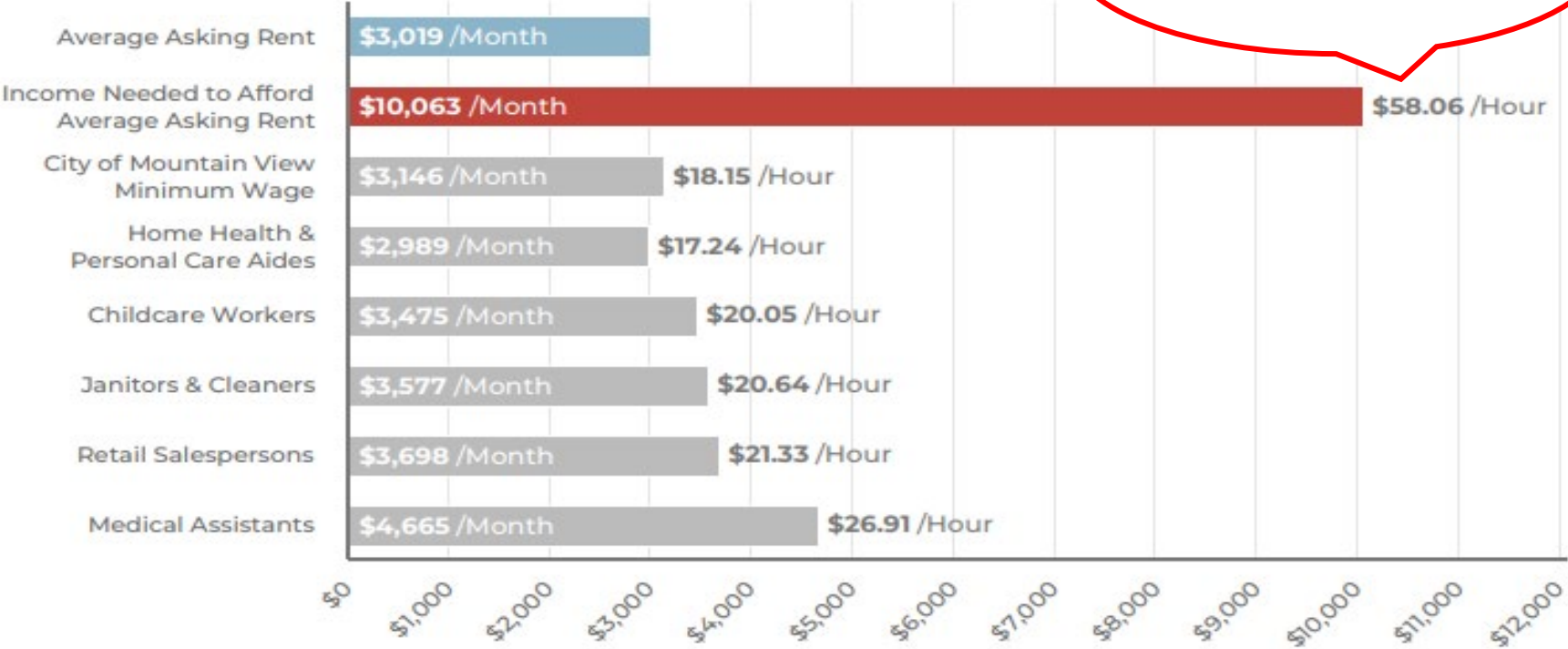

Who Can Afford To Rent In Santa Clara County

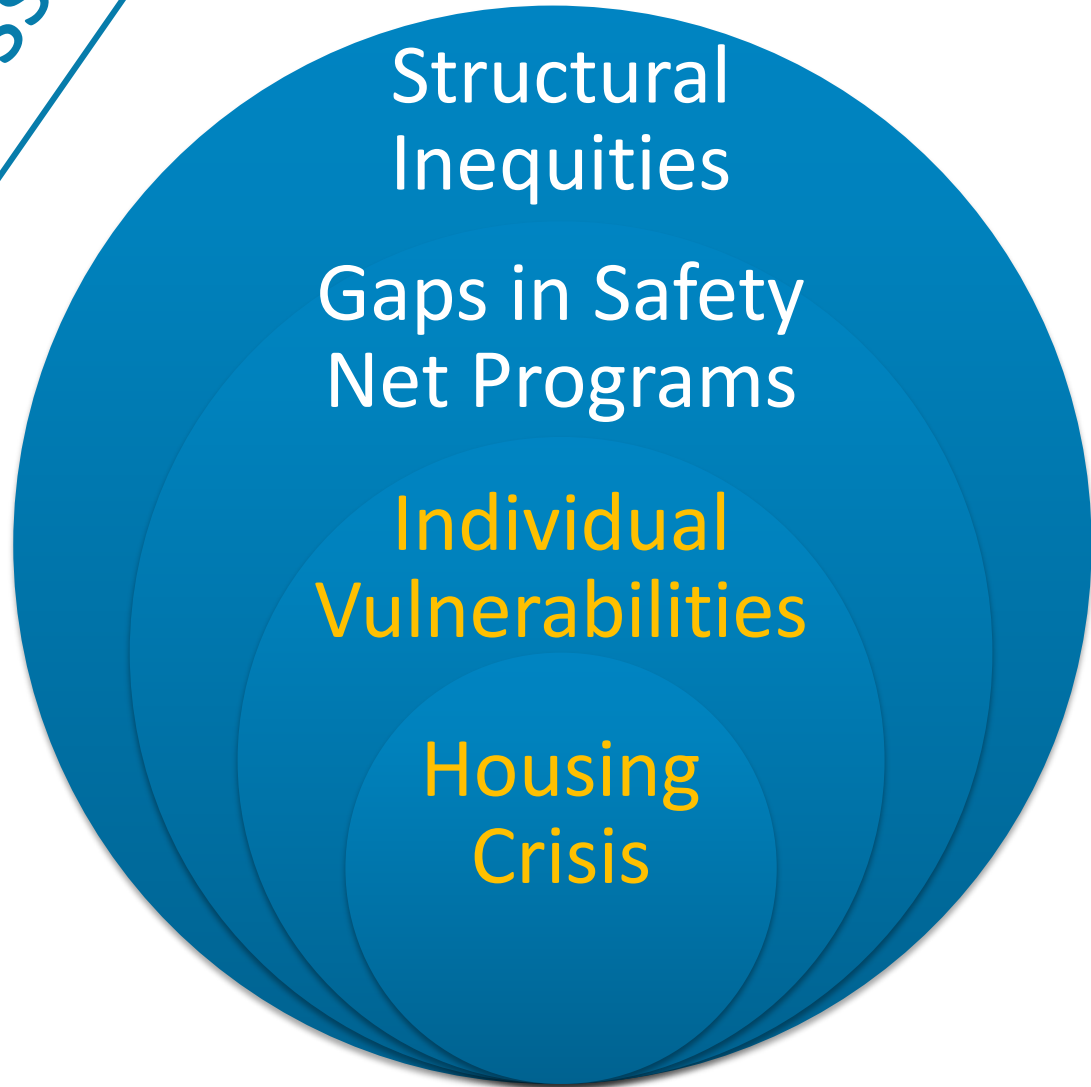
WHO CAN AFFORD TO RENT

Renters need to earn **3.2 times** the minimum wage to afford the average rent in Santa Clara County.

\$120,000/yr



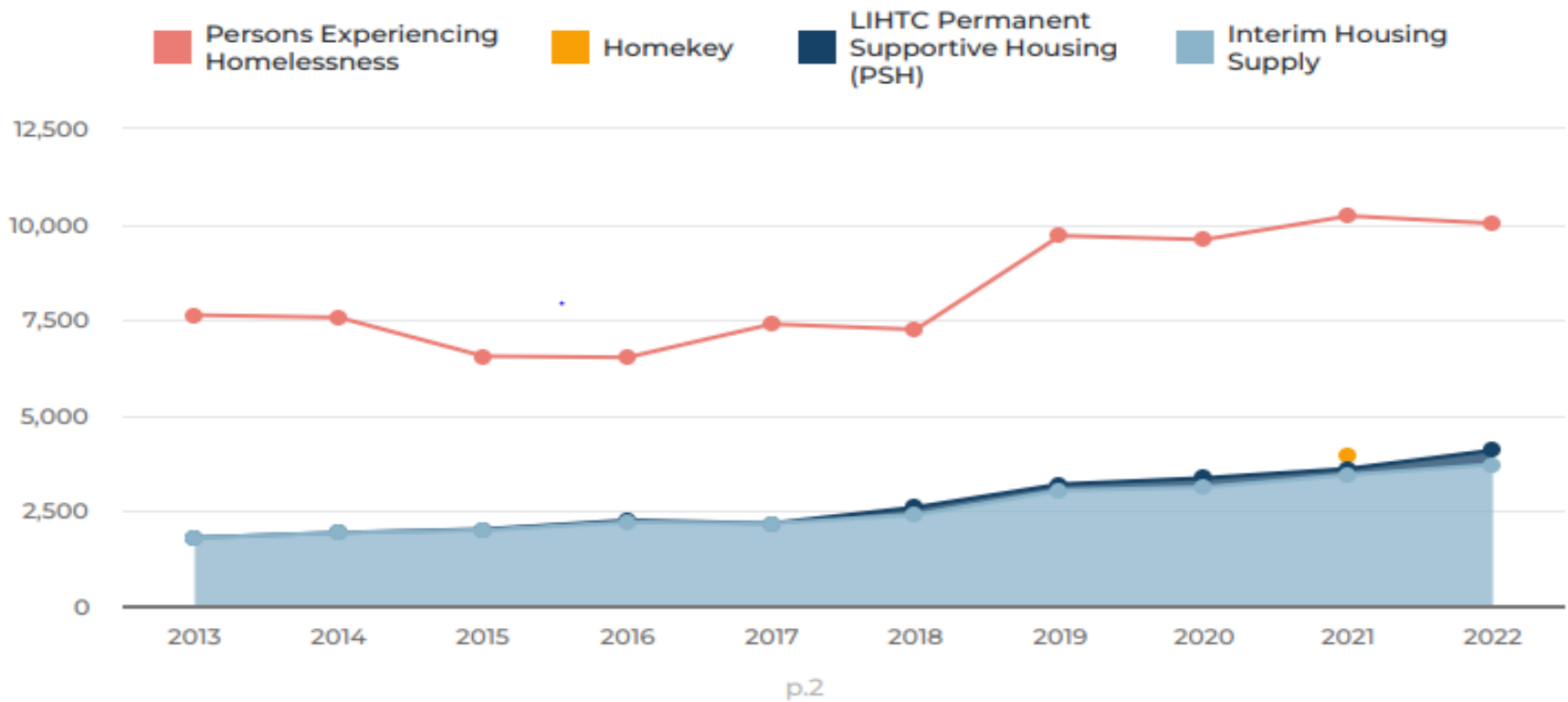
What factors lead to homelessness?

HOUSING FOR PERSONS EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS

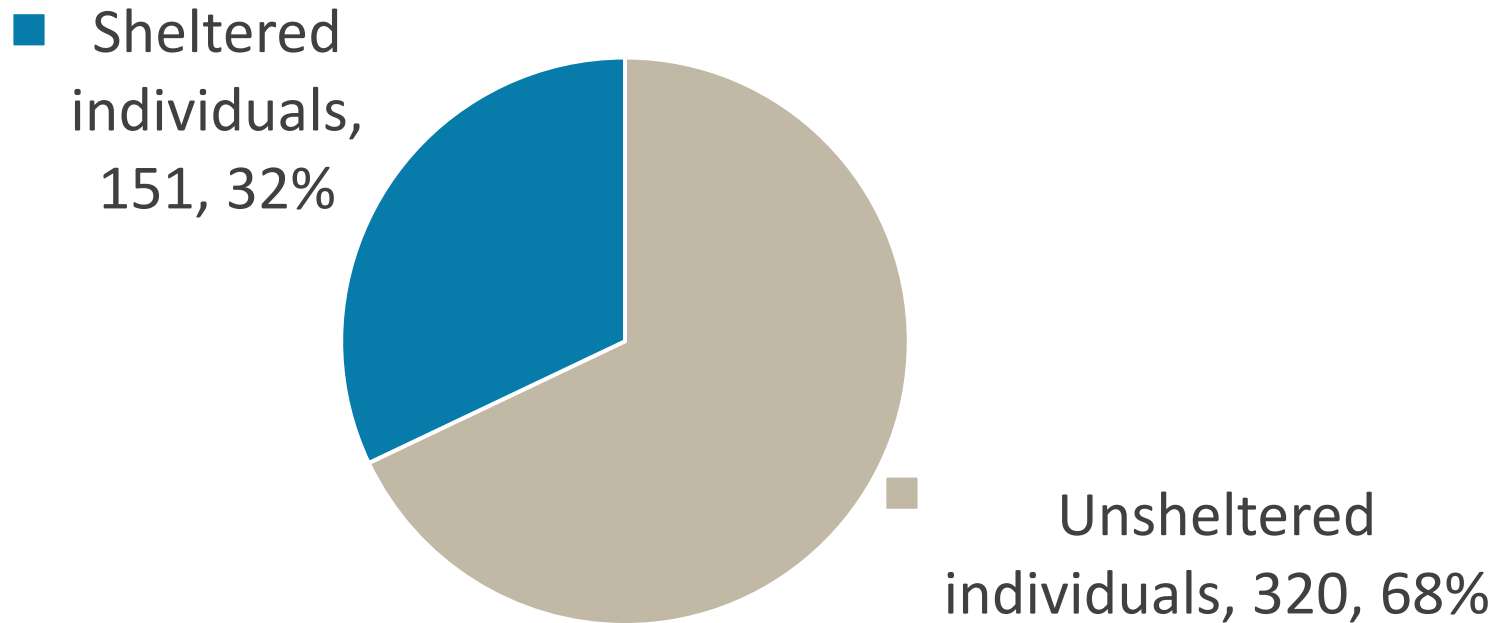
In 2022 in Santa Clara County, there were only **4,096 beds** available in the interim and permanent housing supply for persons experiencing homelessness.

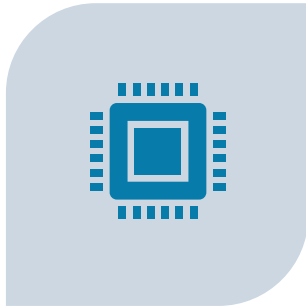
