TDA Article 3 Funding for FY 2025/26

TDA Article 3 Funding for FY 2025/26

- **What can TDA funding be used for?**
 - ◆ Design & construction of a bicycle/pedestrian capital or quick build project
 - ◆ Secured bicycle parking facilities in high use activity areas
 - ◆ Restriping Class II bicycle lanes

- **What did we use TDA funding for last year?**
 - ◆ June 4, 2024, Council made an action:
 - Bank the remaining funds (\$411,038) for the Construction phase of the Installation of Sidewalk on Poplar Avenue

TDA Article 3 Funding for FY 2025/26

- **How much TDA funding do we get each fiscal year?**
 - ◆ About \$140,000/year – based on sales tax

- **How much TDA funding do we have now?**
 - ◆ \$621,513
 - Banked from FY 2024/25 - \$411,038
 - Rescission from previous completed projects - \$210,475

Discussion of Potential Projects

1. Install sidewalk on Poplar Ave near Peterson Middle School

Description

- Construct sidewalk
 - ◆ East side of Poplar Ave
 - ◆ North & South side of Bryant Way (East of Poplar Ave)

Staff Comments

- June 4, 2024, Council made an action:
 - ◆ Bank the remaining funds (\$411,038) for the Construction phase

Yes	Yes	Construction \$895,000

2. Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB) & Curb Extensions

Description

- Design and Construction at:
 - ◆ California Ave. & Frances St. (in ATP)
 - ◆ Sunset Ave. & Washington Ave. (near Park)

Staff Comments

- Locations meet the criteria for RRFB
- Curb Extension to be considered at feasible locations

Yes	Yes	\$700,000

3. Evelyn Avenue Multi-use Trail

Description

- Construct multi-use trail on north side of Evelyn Avenue from Western City Limits to Mathilda Place.

Staff Comments

- Design phase is underway
- Additional funding is needed to complete the construction phase

Yes	Yes	\$300,000

4. Implement crossing improvements at the intersection of Gail Ave & Iris Ave

Description

- High Visibility Crosswalks all 4 legs
- Curb Extensions at Southwest Corner
- Green Stormwater Infrastructure

Staff Comments

- ATP Safe Routes to School for Braly Elementary School

Yes	Yes	\$225,000

5. Reduce pork chop islands on Westbound El Camino Real at Murphy Ave and at Frances St

Description

- Reduce Pork Chop Islands at:
 - ◆ El Camino Real & Murphy Ave
 - ◆ El Camino Real & Frances St

Staff Comments

- Project is feasible
- Provide a more direct and safer path for bicyclists traveling WB


6. Convert all part-time bike lanes on Homestead Road into full-time bike lanes

Description

- Slurry Seal 2026 to cover pavement work
- Install “No Parking Anytime/Bike Lane” signs between Bernardo Ave and Kaiser Entrance

Staff Comments

- Council approved Alternative 2
 - ◆ Convert all part-time bike lanes into full time bike lanes
