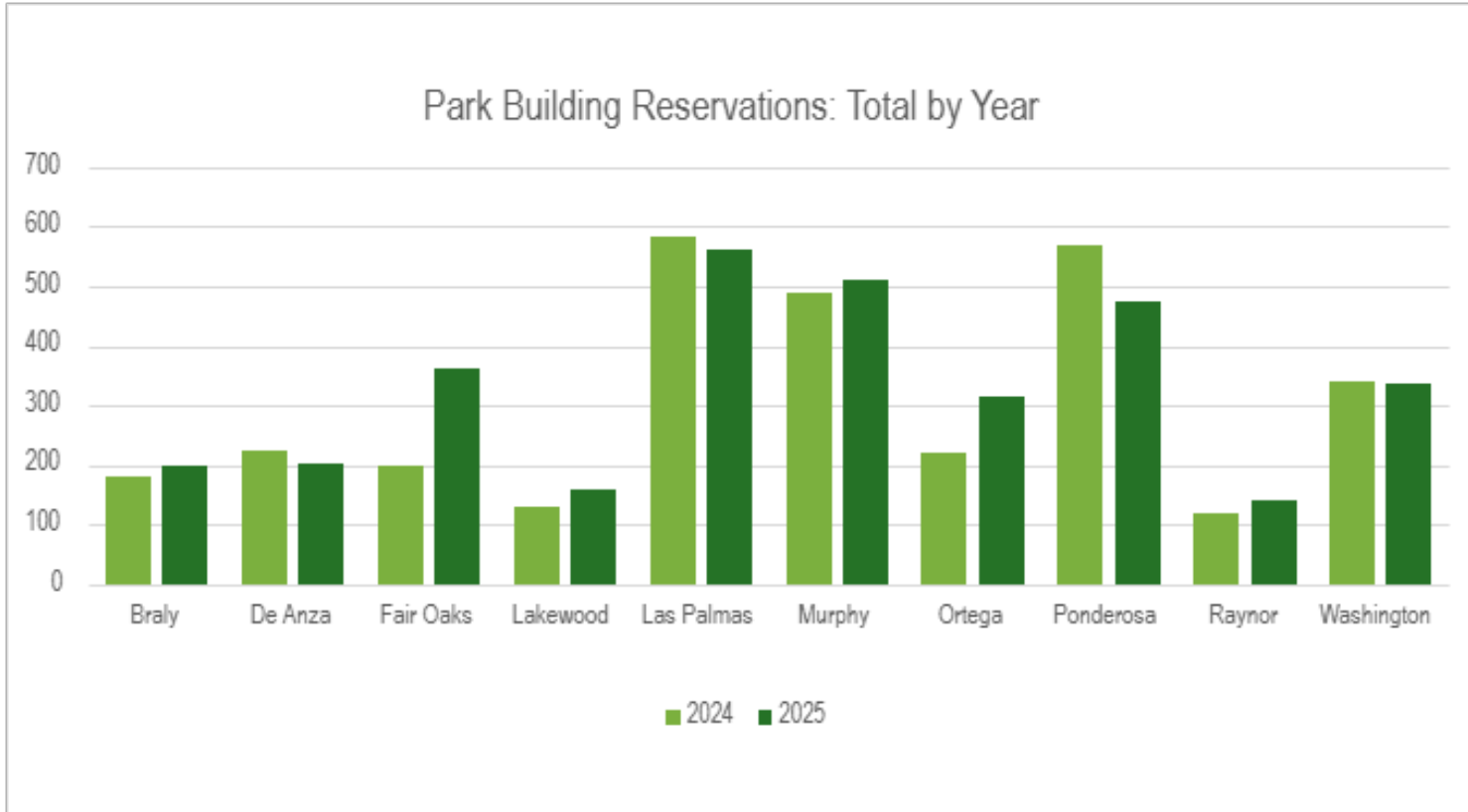

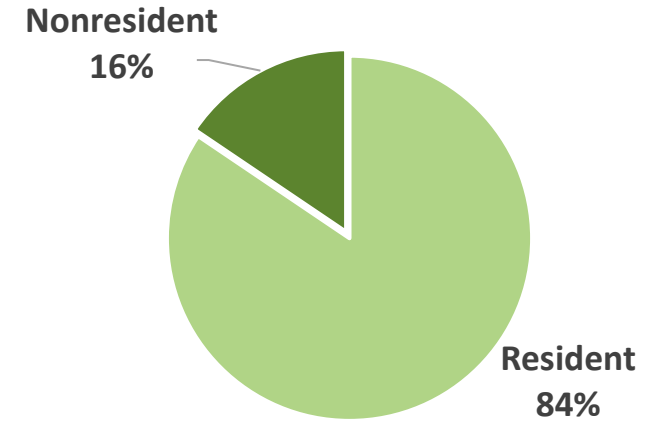

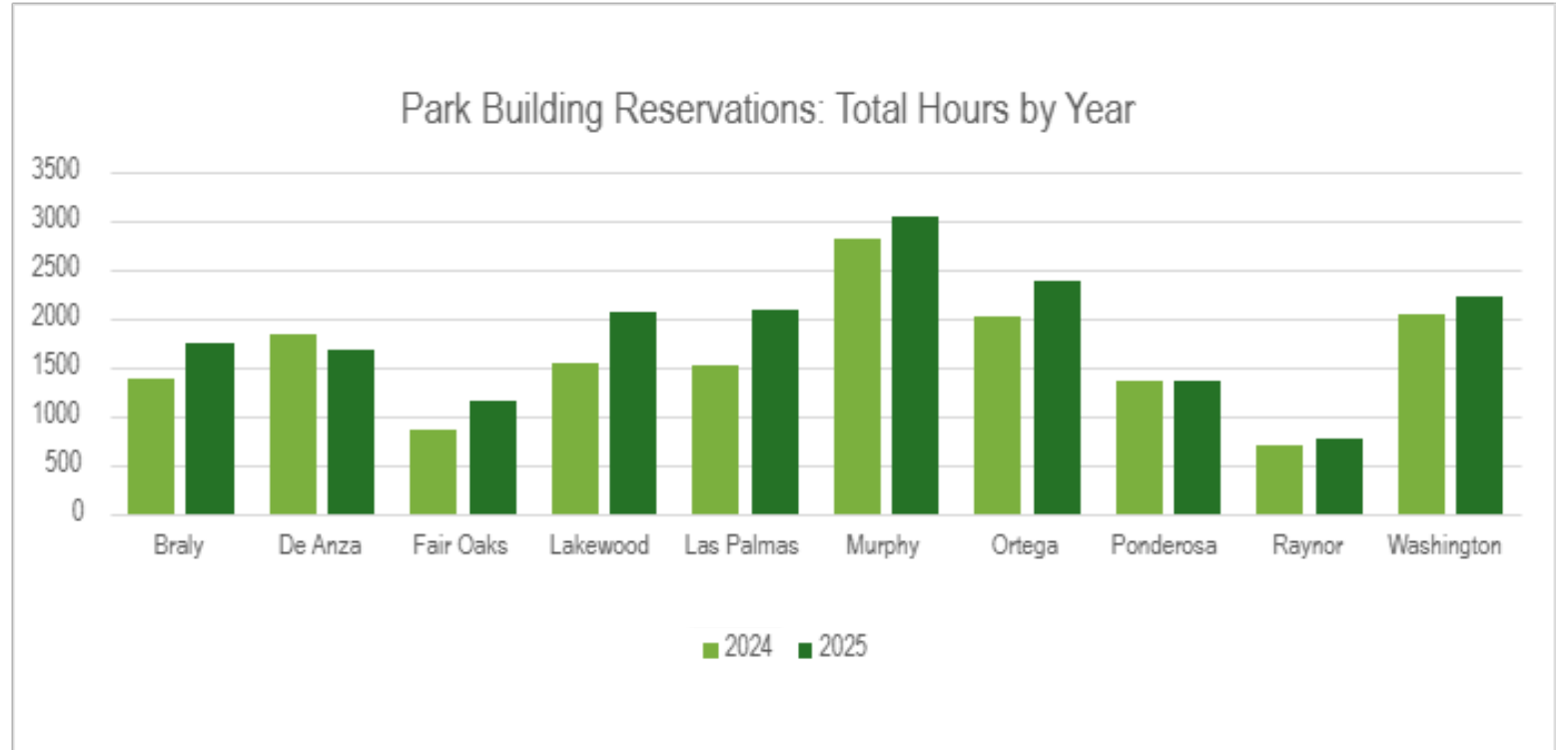


Park Building Reservations:
Resident vs Nonresident



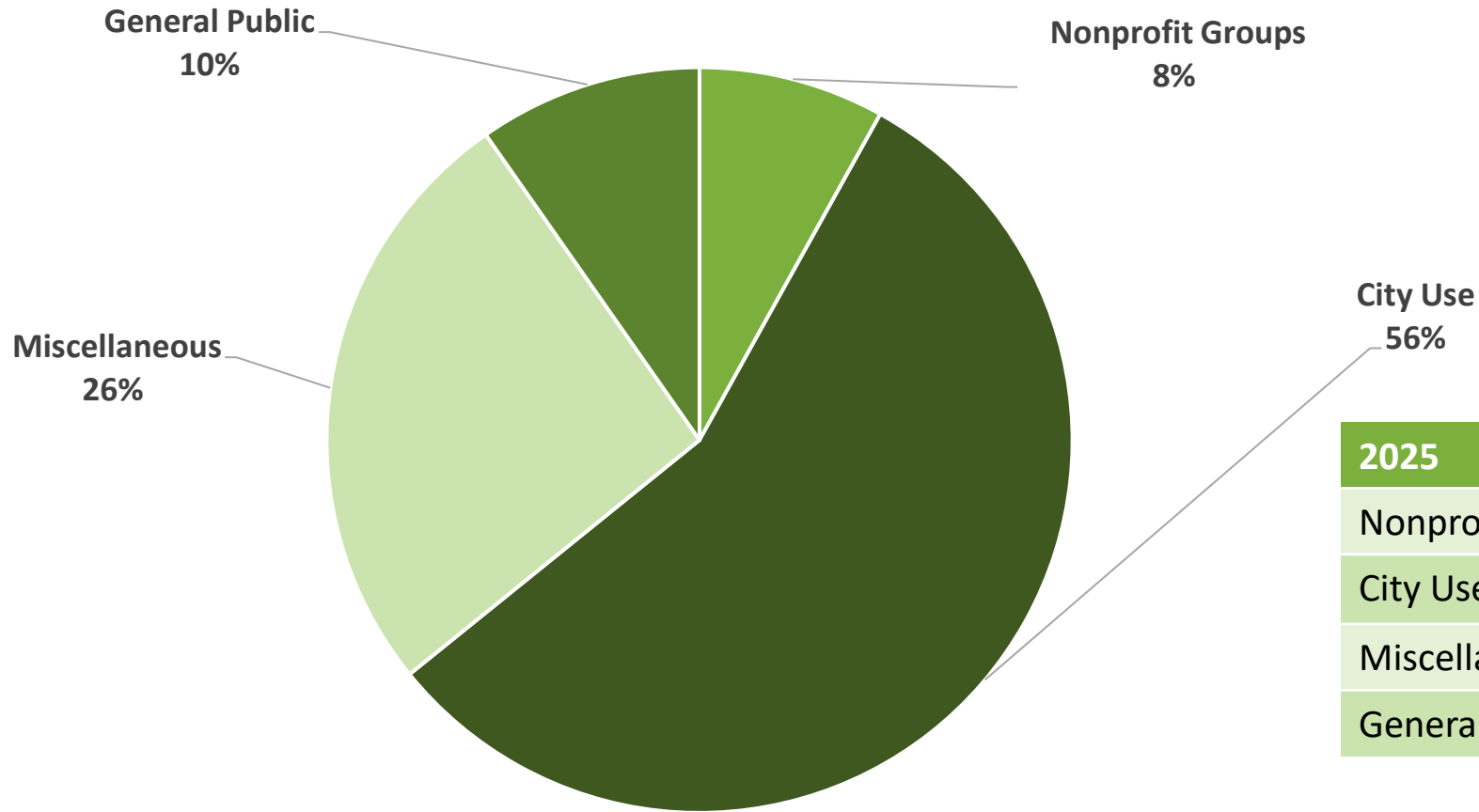

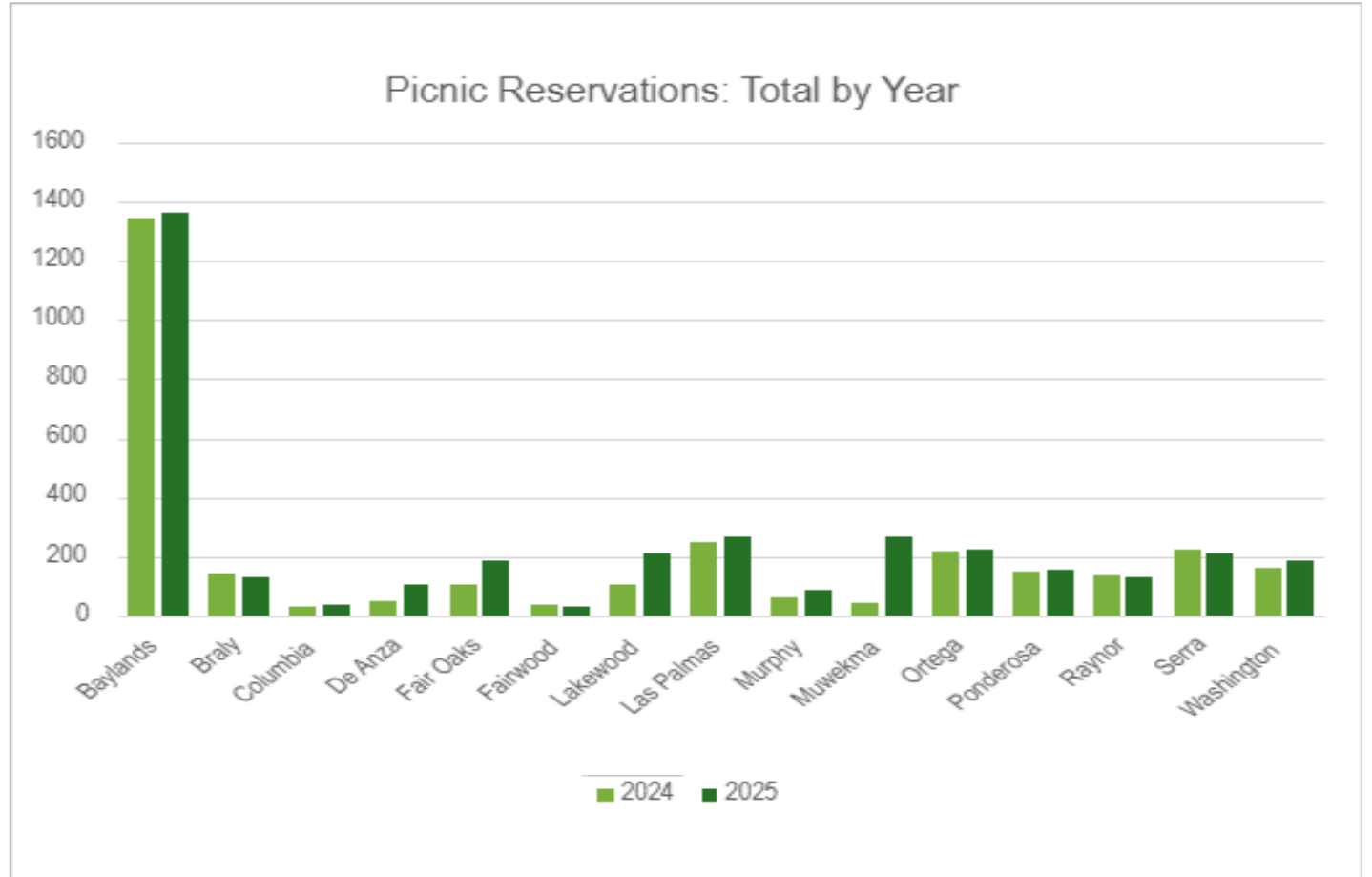

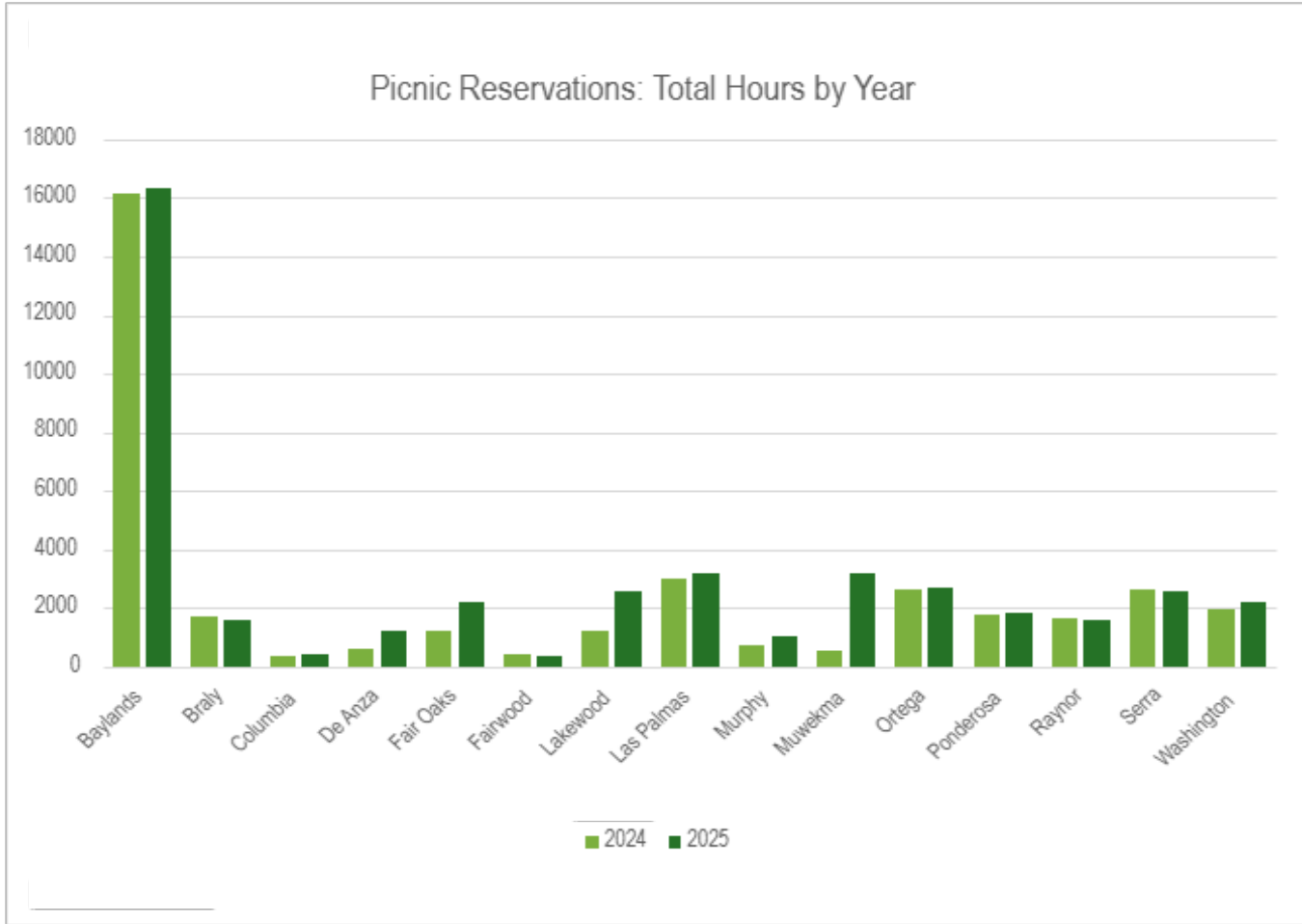

Proposed Rental Changes

Indoor Sports Center and Columbia Gymnasium

- Align rental requirements and operations at both locations and create a more equitable use process
- Each Fall, applications will be accepted for the period of January to December
- Applications will be placed in a draw
- Sunnyvale Residents and Sunnyvale Nonprofits will receive the first draw



Proposed Rental Changes cont'd

Indoor Sports Center and Columbia Gymnasium

- Nonresidents and other nonprofits will be placed in the second draw
- Sunnyvale nonprofit rates will be increased to the resident rate

Fees	Sunnyvale Resident or Sunnyvale Nonprofit	Nonresident
Full Gym	\$135	\$160
Half Gym	\$90	\$108

Rentals require a two-hour minimum

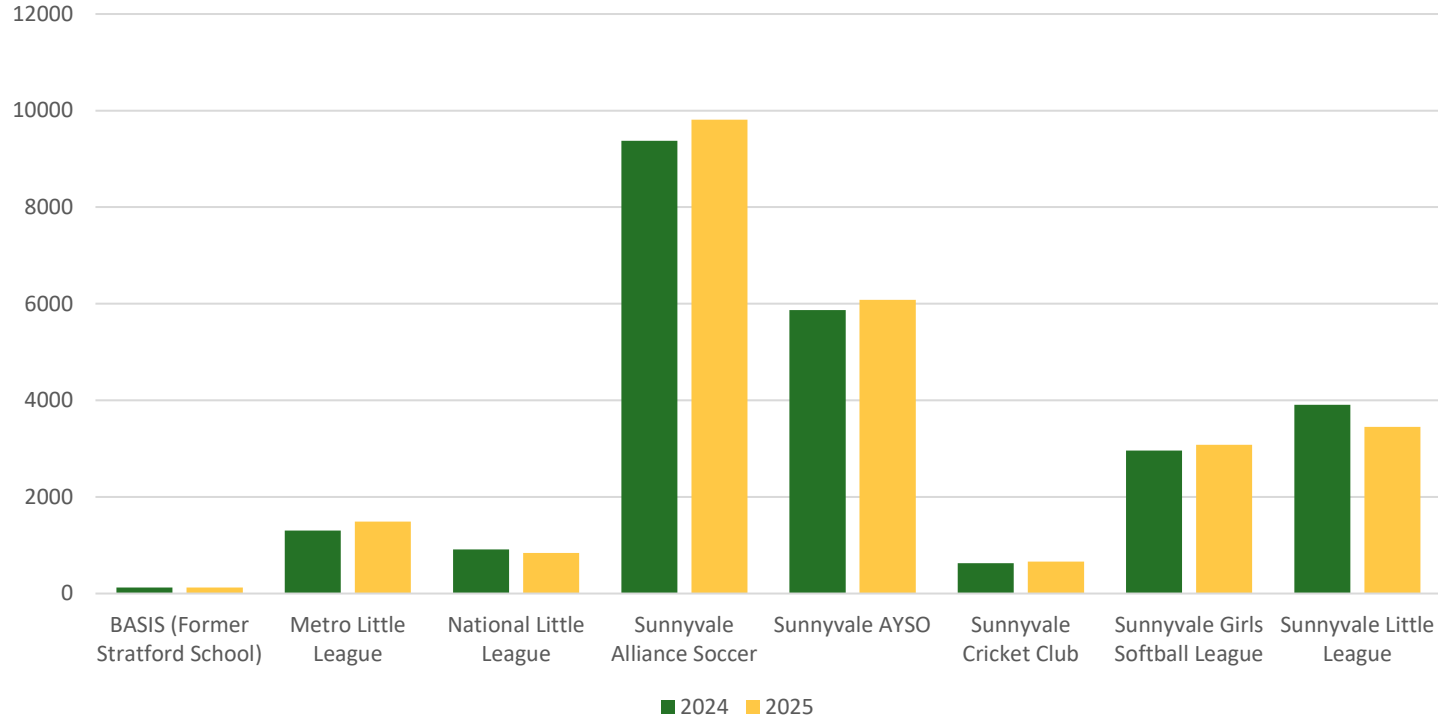

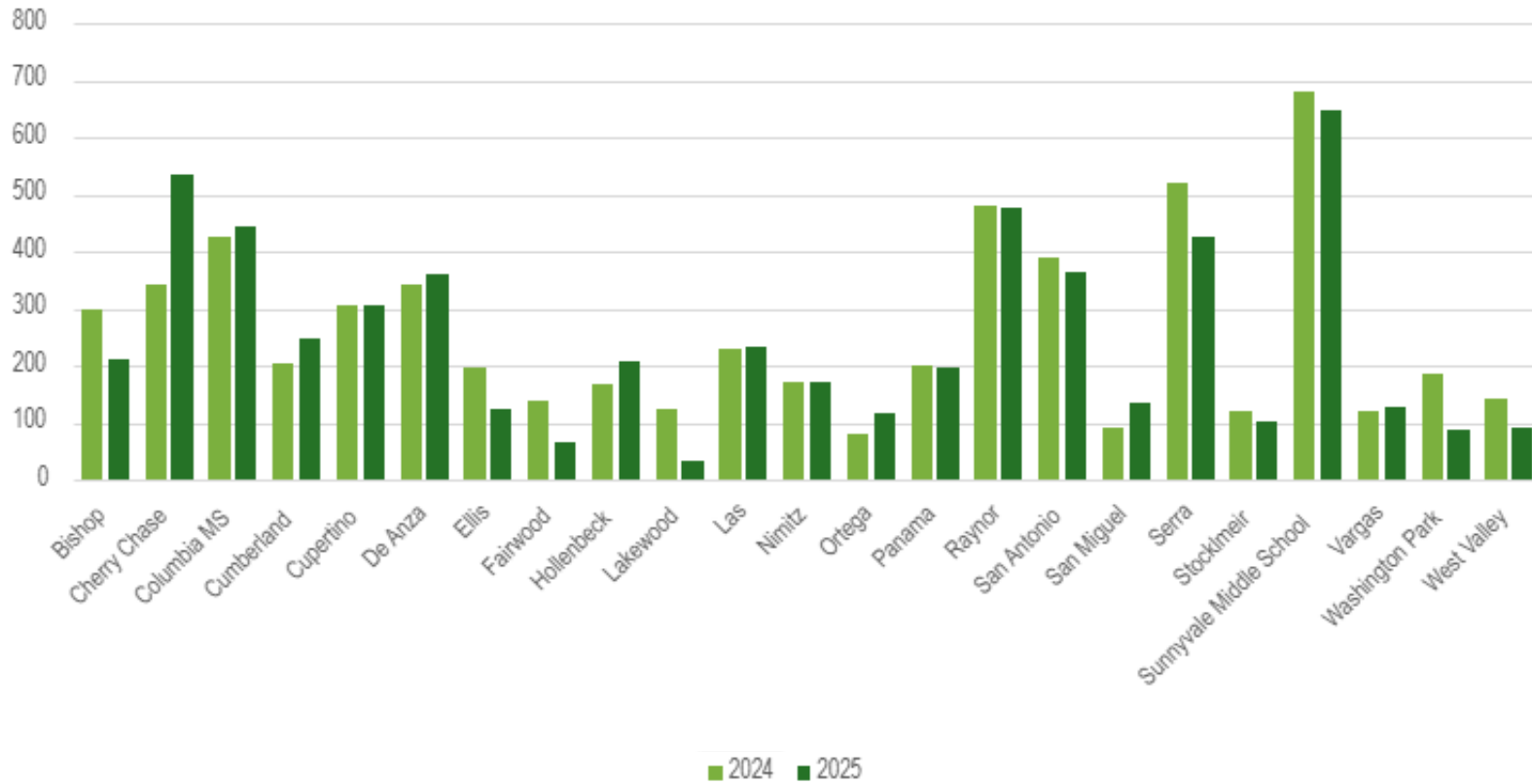
Field Rentals: Total by Organization, Year

Field Rentals – Non-lighted Field Use

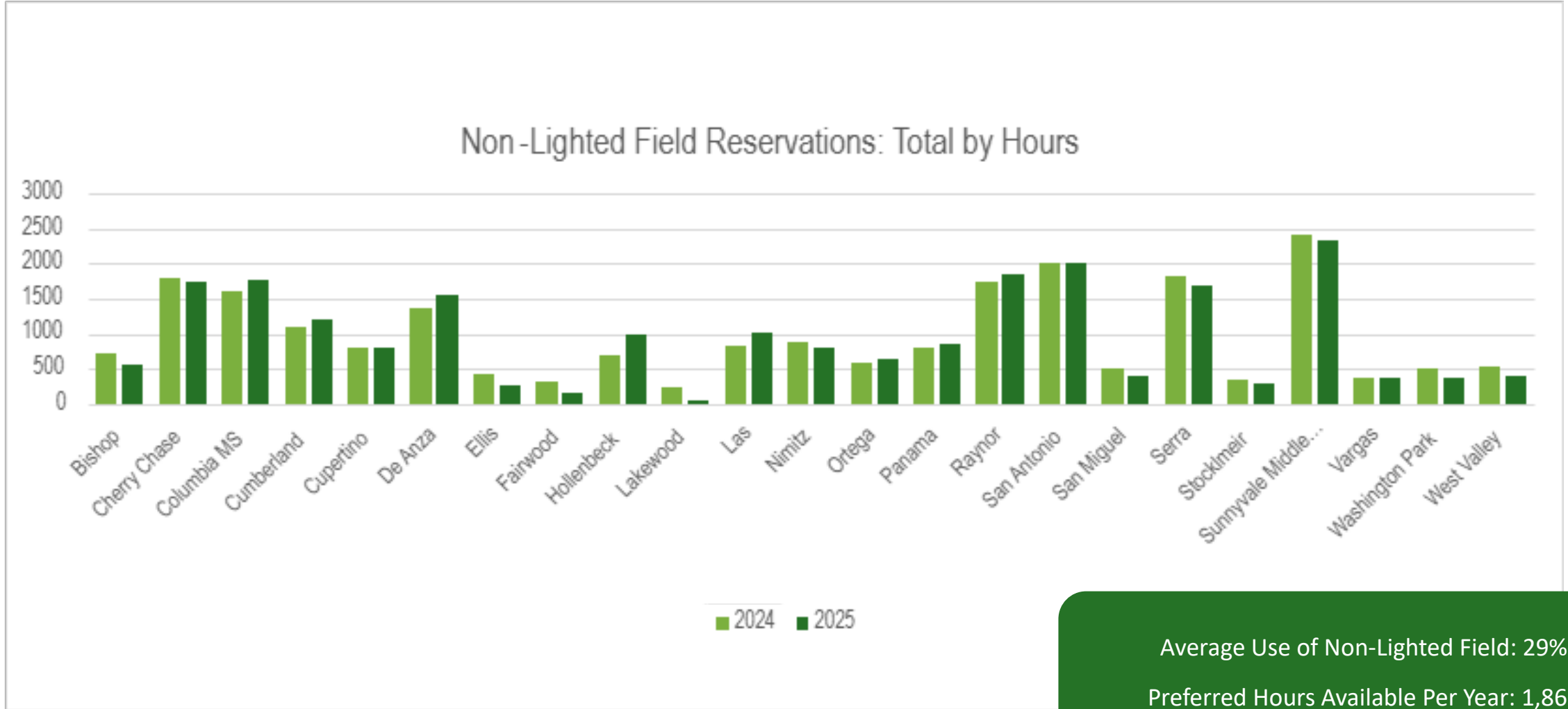
Non-Lighted Field Reservations: Total by Location, Year

 2025 Field Use: 7,915 Reservations

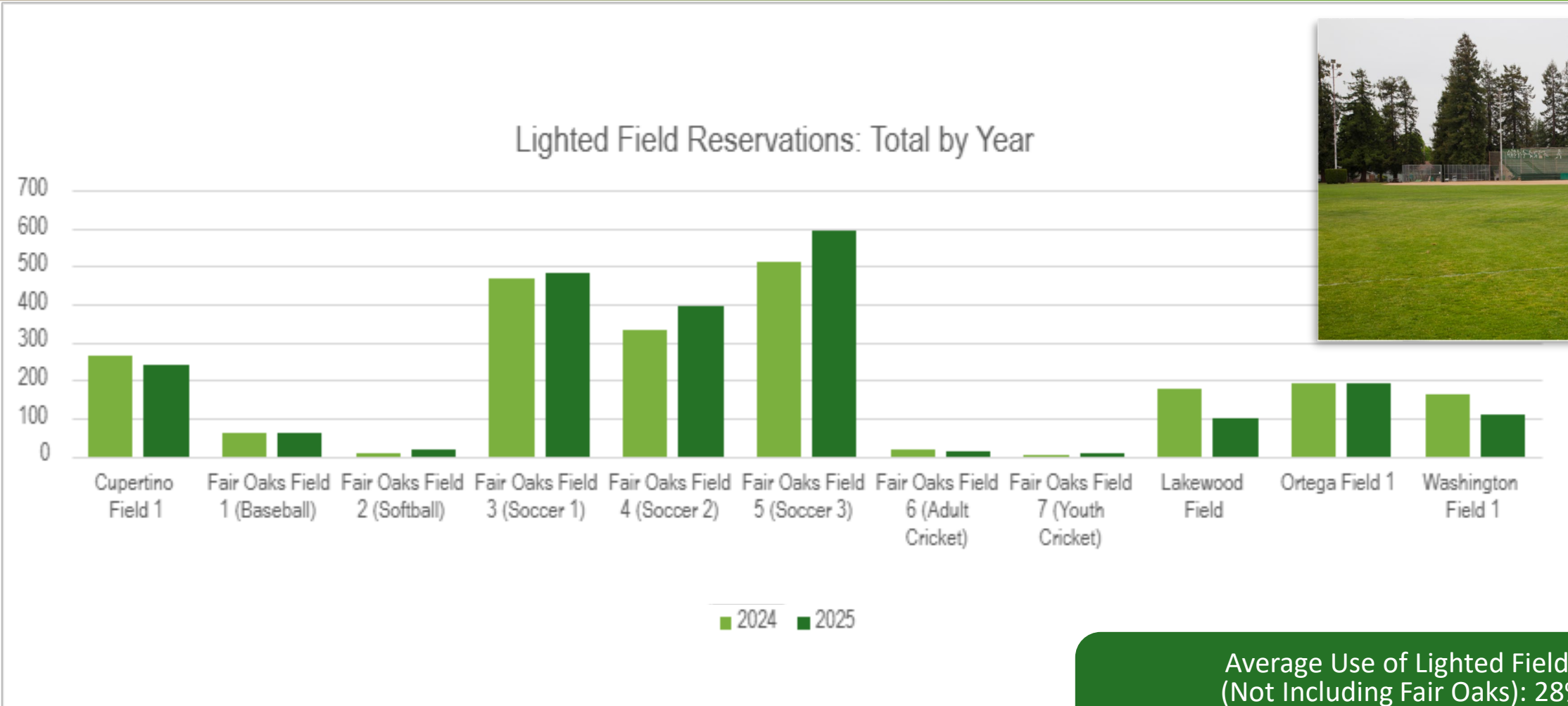


Field Rentals – Non-lighted Field Use

Preferred Hours Available Per Year: 1,865

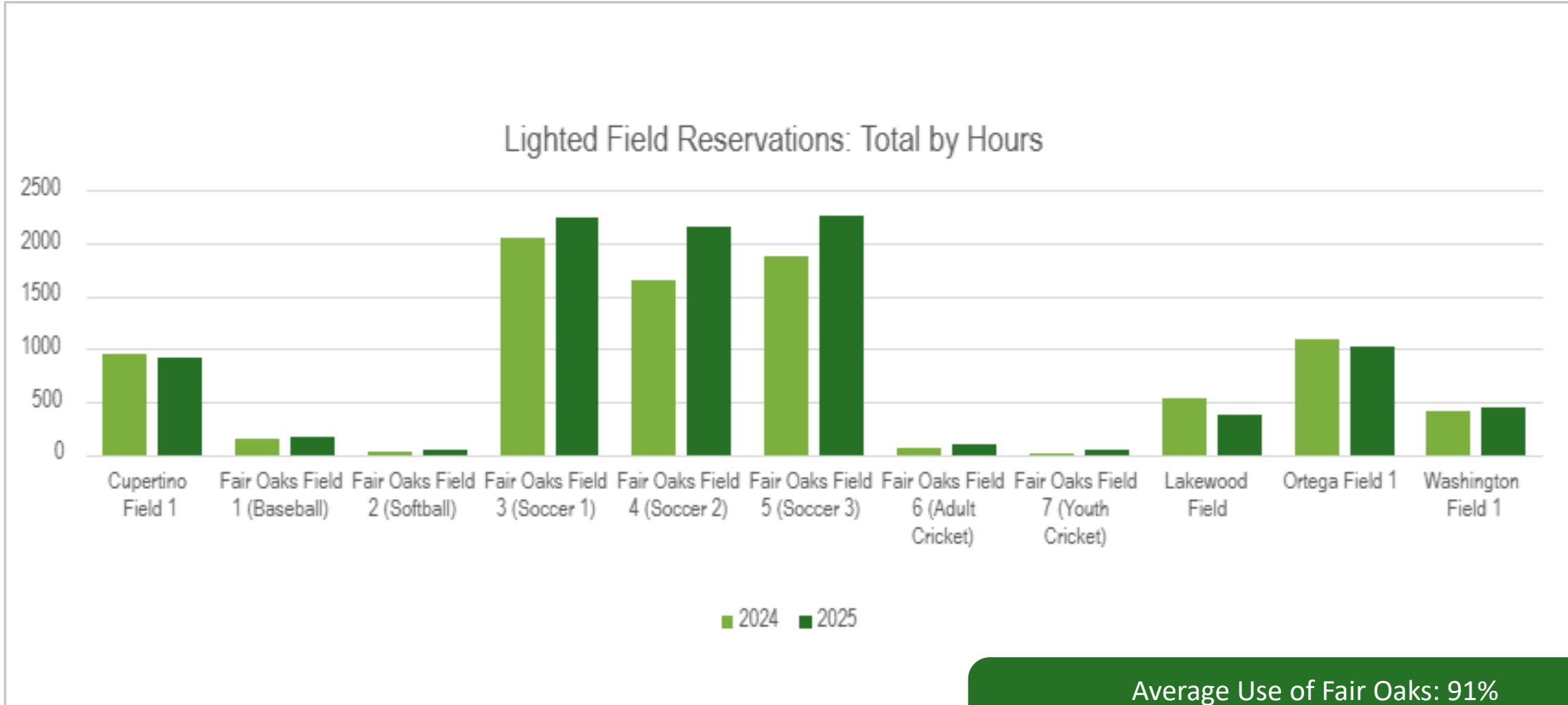
Field Rentals – Non-lighted Field Use
