Jesus Raygoza, Recreation Service Manager, presented an overview of Youth and Teens services. Highlights included: summer camp enrollment totals, year round programs, Columbia Neighborhood Center highlights, teen programming, recruitment, and expansion.

Commissioners asked about volunteer age minimum, camp registration date, and expanding youth and teen programs throughout north/south Sunnyvale locations.

Jim Stark, Superintendent of Parks and Golf, presented a report on Golf and Tennis. He was accompanied by Rodney Wilson, Golf Operations Manager, and Michael Scadden, General Manager of Lifetime Tennis. Highlights included: golf

courses, capital projects, summer camps, restaurants, Las Palmas Tennis Center, state of tennis, pickle ball facility improvements, and introduction of padel.

Commissioners asked how mini golf companies and Top Golf impact golf in general, if there will be open tennis courts for residents residing near Las Palmas Park, adding golfing usage stats to future reports, and use of Park Dedication Fund.
