### **Project History**

- 34.7-acre site previous AMD site developed by the Irvine Company
- As part of the public improvements 6.5-acre park land dedication
- Park improvements \ construction shared by the Irvine Company and capped at \$12 million
  - \$4 million by the Irvine Company
  - \$8 million of Park Dedication Funds
- Park is anticipated to be dedicated to City in June 2022

### Naming Process

- Provided list of names to Parks and Recreation Commission for consideration
