At the Oct 9, 2023, study session of the Sunnyvale Planning Commission, a question was raised about the possible impacts of Applied Materials proposed "EPIC Center" development on the proximate use of Scanning Electron Microscopes (SEM) and Transmission Electron Microscopes (TEM). Applied Materials has been using SEM/TEM equipment in the building next door to the Maydan Technology Center—Applied Materials' current major laboratory—with no discernable impact from lab operations. In addition, we have received no inquiries or complaints from any neighbors over the years who may be operating similar equipment.
