What is the RRN?

- Supports Santa Clara County residents facing ICE arrests
- Offers Know Your Rights education & free legal support
- 24/7 hotline: 408-290-1144
- Volunteers verify ICE presence and provide legal observation

When to Call the Hotline

- You see ICE in your neighborhood
- ICE knocks on your door
- A loved one is detained by ICE

How to Identify ICE

- Dark, unmarked vehicles with tinted windows
- Jackets labeled 'Police' or 'Federal Agent'
- Badges from Department of Homeland Security
