

2023 Summary

- We responded to 384 Traffic Complaints* (175 in 2022): 15* involved "Speeding"
- 3,221 Citations issued for Hazardous Violations (Speed, Stop Signs etc.)
- 3* Citations issued to Pedestrians (Jay Walking, Out of Crosswalk)
- 12* Citations issued to Bicyclist (Signal Violations, Red lights etc.)

Common Violations

■ Pedestrian


- FTY Right of way to ped in road
- Speed
- Unsafe start
- Crossing Guards

■ Bicycle

- FTY Right of way violation
- Improper Turn
- Bicycle wrong direction
- Signs and signals

Education

- Continued use of social media to supplement traffic safety education
 - Nextdoor, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram (traffic safety campaigns)
- Continuation of in person traffic safety education
- We have completed several school bike/ped safety presentations

Enforcement

- Return of County Wide Group Enforcement
- Directed Traffic Enforcement Operations
- Office of Traffic Safety grant programs
 - DUI, Distracted Driving, Bike/Ped, and PCF targets
- Special Enforcement Campaigns
 - Special problem or enforcement areas

■ Bicycle

- Bike lane violation Ops
 - Mathilda Avenue
 - Maude Avenue

- Right of way violations
 - On going
 - Based on traffic flow
