Public Comment - need to check the MTC draft plan report to see if bicycle/ped improvements are underfunded or de-listed as they are lumped under one heading whereas highway improvements are individually listed. "Bike super highway" is of critical importance.

VTA Staff Report - Vice Mayor Linda Sell is Group 5/Northeast regular VTA board member.

Equity In Infrastructure Project Pledge - On 13-JAN-2025 - to ensure historically underutilized business entities (minority/small business/women-owned, etc) - are given opportunities in VTA projects.

Jan 30th 2025: Branham TOD Press Conference to be held - Supportive housing project - offering affordable home ownership on VTA ground leased land.

County Staff Report - VTA ATP comments will be presented as info item - not all items presented will be addressed in responses, but some critical ones will be presented, A spreadsheet of all comments will be published and those comments which are not addressed as part of the plan will be given a clear and rational response as to why. Will occur in March.
