**Recommendation:** Alternative 1: Approve the Special Development Permit and Tentative Map with the recommended findings in Attachment 3 and conditions of approval in Attachment 4. If approved, the project would reinstate a previously approved development and provide new homeownership opportunities. The project is consistent with the R-2/PD zoning district by providing four residential units within two-story buildings. The proposed project is consistent with the neighborhood character, and it is comparable to other small-lot subdivisions in the City.
