TDA Article 3 Funding for FY 2024/25

TDA Article 3 Funding for FY 2024/25

- **What can the funding be used for?**
 - ◆ Design & construction
 - Bicycle/pedestrian capital or quick build project
 - Safe Routes to School projects
- **How much TDA funding do we get?**
 - ◆ About \$140,000/year – based on sales tax
- **How much TDA funding do we have now?**
 - ◆ \$411,038 (combination of last year's banked funds and this year's funds)

Candidate Projects

1. Install Sidewalk on Poplar Avenue

Description

- Complete Sidewalk Gap
 - ◆ East side of Poplar Avenue
 - ◆ North & South side of Bryant Way (East of Poplar Avenue)
- GSI Improvements
- Design & Construction

Staff Comments

- SRTS Improvements for Peterson Middle School
- CIP 835010 – GSI Plan Implementation



In ATP?	Cost
Yes	Construction \$895,000

2. Convert all part-time bike lanes on Homestead Road into full-time bike lanes

Description

- Design & Install:
 - ◆ “No Parking Anytime/Bike Lane” signs
 - ◆ Buffered bike lanes and road diet where possible

Staff Comments

- Council approved to:
 - ◆ Convert all part-time bike lanes into full-time bike lanes

Yes	Design \$110,000 Construction \$520,000

3. Reduce pork chop islands on Westbound El Camino Real at Murphy Avenue and at Frances Street

Description


- Reduce Pork Chop Islands at:
 - ◆ El Camino Real & Murphy Avenue
 - ◆ El Camino Real & Frances Street

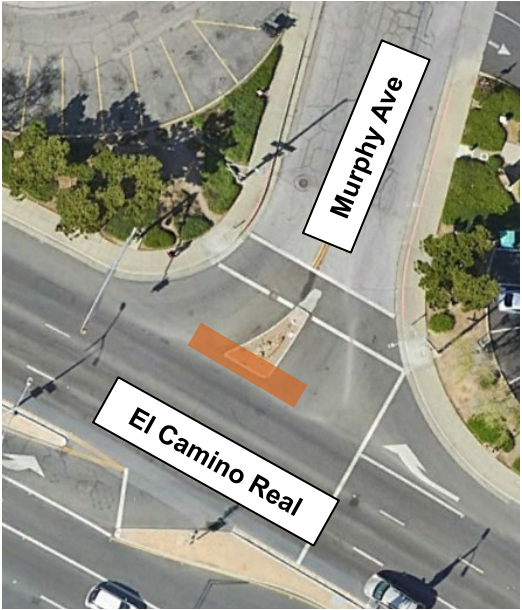
Staff Comments

- Project is feasible
- Provide a more direct and safer path for bicyclists traveling WB

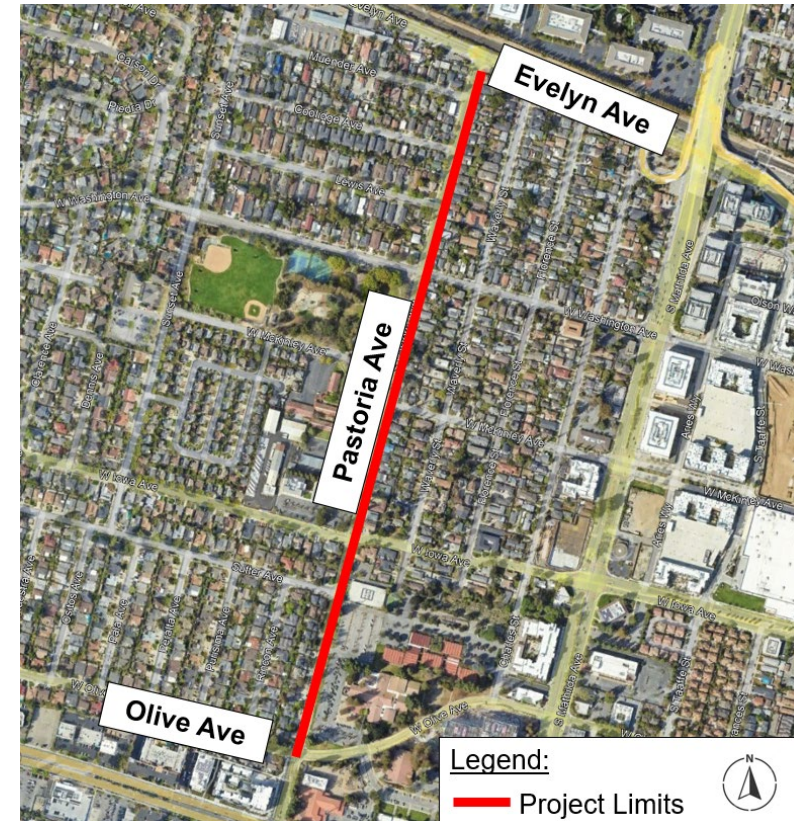
4. Implement Class III Bicycle Route on Pastoria Avenue

Description

- Install “Bicycle May Use Full Lane” signs
- Install Bicycle Sharrow markings
- Install Shoulder Striping
- Install Double Yellow Centerline

Staff Comments

- Adds 1.34 miles (both directions) of Class III Bicycle Route

Yes	\$30,000

5. Widen fence opening at Crawford Drive near Las Palmas Park

Description

- Widen fence opening
- Level the pathway

Staff Comments

- Discussed with City arborist
- Widen fence is feasible

No	\$130,000

Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission (BPAC) Recommendation

BPAC Recommendation: 6-0 Vote, 1 Commissioner Absent

- **Alternative 2:** Recommend to City Council to use the FY 2024/25 TDA Article 3 grant fund for:
 - ◆ Project No. 2 - Convert all part-time bike lanes on Homestead Road into full-time bike lanes (Design Phase: \$110,000)
 - ◆ Bank the remaining funds (\$301,038) for future use

Recommendation to City Council

Justification

- **City Council's Priority:**
 - ◆ **Project No. 1 - Install Sidewalks on Poplar Avenue**
 - Will close sidewalk gap and provide improved, connected, safe and convenient walking and biking access to Peterson Middle School students
 - June 20, 2023 City Council Meeting - Approved to use \$160,000 of FY 2023/24 TDA Article 3 grant fund for the design, and bank the remainder of the funding for the construction phase
 - February 6, 2024 City Council Meeting - Reaffirmed action to reserve future TDA Article 3 funding allocations for the Construction Phase
