A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE  
DISSOLVING THE HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION

WHEREAS, On November 29, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 1159-22, establishing the Human Relations Commission (“HRC”), and

WHEREAS, the HRC was tasked with advising on policies related to diversity, equity, access, inclusion, justice, and belonging, as well as promoting engagement among Sunnyvale’s diverse communities; and

WHEREAS, the HRC has served as a valuable forum for community dialogue on equity, access, and inclusion; and

WHEREAS, the primary focus of the HRC’s work has been community engagement, education, and awareness-building efforts and events that require significant planning and coordination and staff has found that these functions are not well-matched to the formal commission structure; and

WHEREAS, to address these operational issues, the City desires to dissolve the HRC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE THAT:

1. The Human Relations Commission is hereby dissolved and Resolution No. 1159-22 is repealed, effective April 10, 2026.
2. The City Manager is authorized to update all policies and other materials as necessary to reflect the dissolution of the Human Relations Commission.
