Our Community Outreach Meeting in December yielded quite a bit of feedback from the neighbors. Most of the comments were in line with what the intended scope of the project. Please take a look at the summary below of both the discussions and the board imagery voting.

Community Outreach Meeting 12/15/16 Summary

- Attendance – 14 Community Members, 5 Staff Members
- Major concerns/desires
 - o Parking
 - Is there a way to joint use with the school parking on weekends?
 - o Mold Elimination – there is currently mold at the existing swim center and pool deck
 - o Hours of Operation
 - Please extend hours of operation
 - Year round facility preferred
 - Enclosed? Retractable roof?
 - Heated pool
 - o Lane Lines for lap swimming desired
 - o Maintain benches/seating around the pool
 - o Multiple Aquatic Areas desired
 - Currently the entire pool is taken up when there are swim lessons
 - Separate pool areas?
 - o Take advantage of the unique park setting
 - Lawn/Turf areas for picnic, family seating
 - Park integration
 - Tree preservation
 - o Separate activity areas
 - Outdoor ping pong?

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- o Shade is very important
 - Shaded area for parent observation of kid lessons
 - Lots of shade needed
- o Water play & recreation need to be incorporated
- o Lounge area
- o Snack bar desired
- Images that were most liked
 - o Entry
 - Large metal and wood canopies
 - o Site features
 - Boat bench
 - Stamped concrete
 - Star benches
 - Other comments
 - Rockwall?
 - Grass play area
 - o Building Style
 - Preferences for Contemporary Farmhouse, Classic, and Modern
 - o Materials
 - Preference for backlit screens with linear cuts, wood and metal combinations
 - o Community Spaces
 - Preferences for large sliding and folding glass doors
 - Interest in “party room” functioning as a secondary community meeting space, fitness room, or class room
 - Interest in a “floating” reception desk
 - Other comments
 - Welcoming reception area
 - Multi-purpose
 - Snack bar & café
 - o Shade Structures & canopies
 - Interest in
 - PV integrated shade structures
 - Shade structures with wave and flying forms
 - Colorful canopies
 - Cut metal
 - o Activity Structures and Splash Pads
 - Comments
 - Taller and wider slides
 - Yes, Dump bucket!

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- Interest in
 - Whale themed splash pad photo – larger themed splash pad with variety of toys
 - Play structures with standing pool, dump bucket and slides
 - Splash pad with climbing structure
- Pool Activities
 - Large selection of classes for seniors, adults, kids lesson and therapeutic needs
 - More / longer lap lanes for swimming
 - Diving board
 - Keep basic style and depth of current pool but add lap lanes
 - Two pools for multiple use
 - Zero entry accessibility
 - We like Blackberry farm for the lawn areas integrated into the pool deck/area
 - Make the pool a part of the park – do not create a harsh separation
 - Swim in movies
