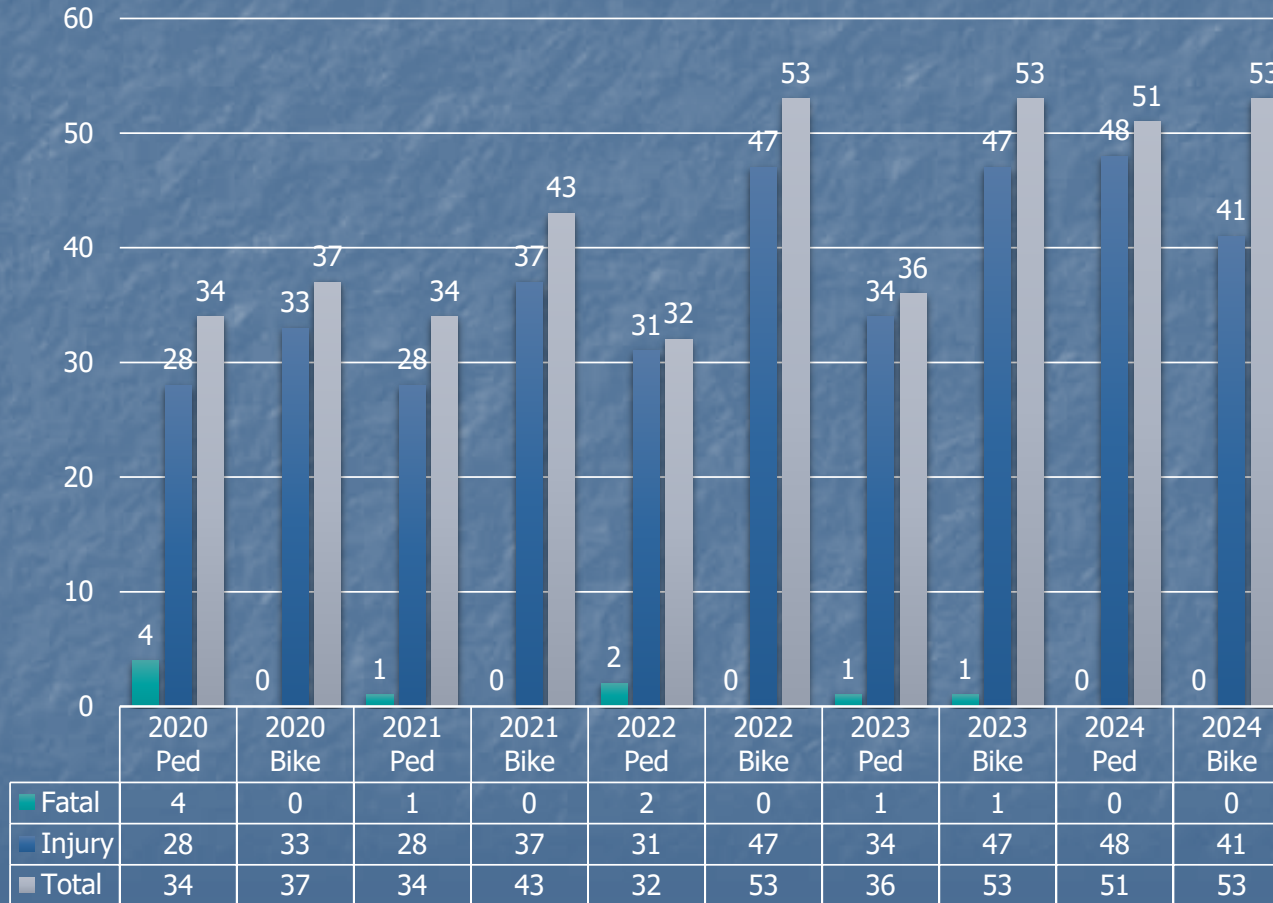

2024 Summary

- Traffic Complaints
 - 463 in 2024 vs. 384 in 2023
 - 185* involved “Speeding”
- Citations Issued:
 - Moving Violations – 4,363
 - Speed, Stop Signs etc.
 - To Pedestrians – 8
 - Jay Walking, Out of Crosswalk
 - To Bicyclists – 90
 - Signal Violations, Red lights etc.

Common Violations

■ Pedestrian

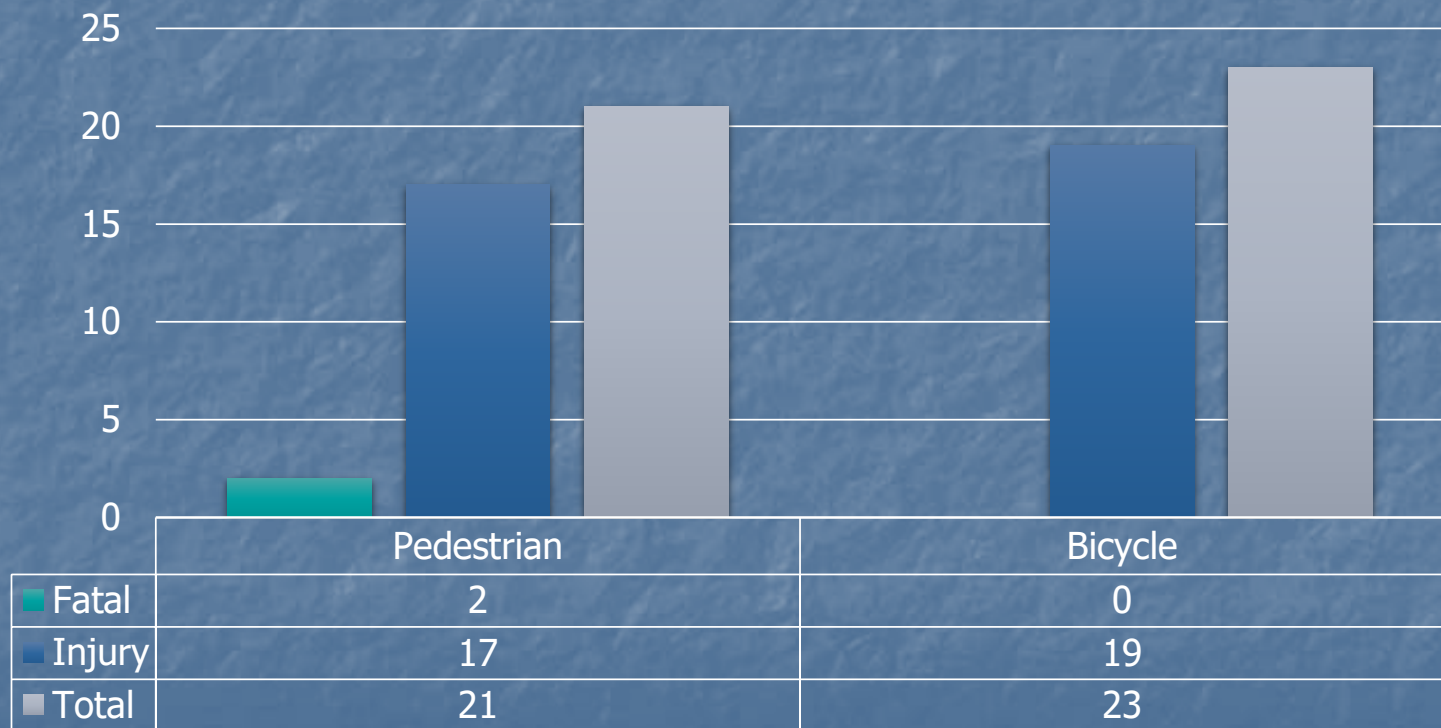
- FTY Right of way to ped in road
- Speed
- Unsafe start
- Crossing Guards

■ Bicycle

- FTY Right of way violation
- Improper Turn
- Bicycle wrong direction
- Signs and signals

The Three E's

- Engineering
- Education
- Enforcement



Engineering

- Coordinate and share observations with Department of Public Works (DPW) to evaluate potential engineering improvements

Education

- Social media to supplement traffic safety education
 - Nextdoor, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram (traffic safety campaigns)
- In-person traffic safety education
- School bike/ped safety presentations

Enforcement

- Return of Countywide Group Enforcement
- Directed Traffic Enforcement Operations
- Office of Traffic Safety grant programs
 - DUI, Distracted Driving, Bike/Ped, and PCF targets
- Special Enforcement Campaigns
 - Special problem or enforcement areas

- Pedestrian Decoy Ops
- Pedestrian due regard
- Crossing Guards
- Heavy Focus on School Zone

■ Bicycle

- Bike lane violation Ops
 - Mathilda Avenue
 - Maude Avenue
 - Wolfe Road
 - School Zones
- Right of way violations
 - On going
 - Based on traffic flow
