Council Policy	Summary of Proposed Change
Policy 3.2.2 <i>Reusable Diapers</i>	Delete – Policy superseded by Council Policy 3.2.4 Zero Waste
Policy 3.7.2 <i>Reduction of Carbon Dioxide Emissions from City Operations</i>	Delete – Policy superseded by the City’s comprehensive Climate Action Plan (CAP) which now serves as the primary policy framework for greenhouse gas emissions’ reduction from City operations and community-wide sources
Policy 5.1.1 <i>Socio-Economic — Goals and Policies</i>	Amend – Update to modernize language and eliminate outdated references
Policy 7.3.7 <i>Standard Conflict of Interest Code</i>	Delete – Policy restates legal obligations imposed by state law. The City will continue to review and update the Code as required. The Code will remain publicly accessible through the City Clerk’s Filing Obligations webpage, and through NetFile.
Policy 7.3.8 <i>Posting of Agendas and Procedure for Confirming Proper Posting and Notice of Meetings</i>	Delete – Policy restates requirements of the Ralph M. Brown Act; removal would simplify the manual and remove redundancy
Policy 7.3.11 <i>Seating Arrangements/City Council</i>	Amend – Minor update to eliminate gendered language
Policy 7.3.31 <i>Guidelines for Council Action on Matters Outside its Subject Matter Jurisdiction</i>	Adopt – Adopt policy to clarify when the City Council may take official City positions (e.g., resolutions) on matters outside the City’s jurisdiction.
Policy 7.4.1 <i>Provision of Staff/Administrative Support to Councilmembers</i>	Amend – Update for consistency with the 2026 Code of Ethics and Conduct for Elected and Appointed Officials regarding use of City letterhead
