History - Fair Oaks Ave. Bike Lane and Streetscape Project

City Council, June 6, 2017 (RTC No. 17-0502)

- Segment 1 – Between Old San Francisco Road and Evelyn Avenue
 - ◆ Approved Design Alternative B: Installation of Class III Sharrows in both directions while maintaining the two-way center left turn lane and **on-street parking**
- Segment 2 – Between Kifer Road and Arques Avenue
 - ◆ Approved Design Alternative B: Installation of Class III Sharrows in both directions
- Segment 3 – Between Wolfe Road and Ahwanee Avenue
 - ◆ Approved Design Alternative A: Installation of Class III Sharrows in both directions

Today – Colleagues Memorandum - February 25, 2025

- Reconsideration approval of the Council decision to maintain on-street parking on Fair Oaks Ave.
 - ◆ Would allow future studies to consider on-street parking removal on Fair Oaks Ave.
 - ◆ Would not create a project or change existing conditions

Alternatives

1. Rescind previous Council action (RTC No. 17-0502) which required on street parking along Fair Oaks Avenue between Old San Francisco Road and Evelyn Avenue to be preserved where currently existing.
2. Do not rescind previous Council action (RTC No. 17-0502) and continue requiring on-street parking along Fair Oaks Avenue between Old San Francisco Road and Evelyn Avenue be preserved where currently existing.
3. Alternative direction as outlined by Council.
