4. What motivated you to apply for this board or commission?

As a commissioner for parks and recreation I have enjoyed working with city staff and the public to make out parks a better place. Key projects I have worked on are study issues to facilitate hitting cages for shared use by cricket and little league teams, the on line permit search of parks that have been reserved for use, and pushing to open up the PGE lands in cherry chase along Lois Avenue.

Key presentations I have enjoyed and been able to assist in review for public discourse have been the Urban Trees presentation by Leonard Dunn, the Muwekma park naming presentation, and the annual review of the Parks Development Fund.

As a licensed architect I am more aligned with the planning and zoning commission as my specific skill set would be better used in this commission. I have enjoyed being on the Parks and Rec commission but feel my time spent in civic duty would be maximized by focusing on planning a zoning, an area that I have much more experience in.

As a licensed architect specializing in residential construction, with several projects completed in Sunnyvale, I am well-equipped to serve on the planning and zoning commission for the city. Attending a city council meeting can be an excellent way to learn about the inner workings of local government and the issues that affect your community. During a typical city council meeting, attendees can expect to learn about a variety of topics related to the governance of the city, including:

While attending the study issue ranking for 2022 I came to have a fuller understanding of the publics part in developing policy. I had proposed putting a dog park in the Lois avenue PGE land in south Sunnyvale, and though everyone on city council seemed to love the idea, a few neighbors who had been trespassing on PG&E land for decades managed to motivate and kill the project, as it appeared to be a dog only use concept, which was in reality only part of the project. I look forward to learning from this process and getting better and pushing projects forward in Sunnyvale.

17. Sunnyvale has limited vacant land for new development. This could increase pressure for redevelopment of existing developed areas. How can planning respond to this situation?

There are several compelling reasons why rezoning existing developed areas for greater densification along major traffic hubs is a smart strategy for promoting sustainable growth and development in our communities.

First and foremost, densification along major traffic hubs can help reduce our reliance on cars and promote more sustainable transportation options. 11. What do you think are major equity challenges facing the Sunnyvale community?

Cars are expensive; public transit can always be improved; time is always short; housing is even and ever shorter.

12. Please describe your experience working with historically marginalized communities. How have your actions benefited these communities?

I haven't had the opportunity to work with historically marginalized communities in quite some time, but when I was younger I spent some time helping residents of Baltimore fight illegal evictions and before then I spent some time volunteering as a counselor in a queer youth center for at-risk-of-being-disowned kids in Tel Aviv. In the former case, I helped people maintain their access to housing or to get a payout settlement; in the latter case, I hope some of them felt better after a cup of tea, someone to talk to, and an internet connection that was safe from their parents.

17. Sunnyvale has limited vacant land for new development. This could increase pressure for redevelopment of existing developed areas. How can planning respond to this situation? Reduce the mandatory parcel sizes, remove the caps on density, make it easier to build denser and higher around transit nodes, and improve transit. The solution to having a higher need for services (like, oh, housing) than supply is to increase the supply. But of course how planning *can* respond to this situation is ultimately not just a technical matter; it's a political matter, and the Commission is ultimately serving in an advisory role. If the City Council wants a policy target that is "fight redevelopment, don't build, keep supply low", I don't know what planning can do about that situation, especially given the Housing Element mandates.
18. Planning Commissioners are often asked to consider social, economic and environmental issues when reviewing proposals. How does one achieve a balanced community?
I don't pretend to have an answer offhand for this. Creating additional supply will reduce the eviction pressures, there can be pressures against long-term vacancies of both business and personal real estate, there are levers to incentivize one kind of store or disincentivize another, and more. But in general I believe that a balanced community is well served by short distances to essential services (like groceries), long-term housing stability, parks that are well-maintained and well-equipped, narrow residential roads, walkable downtown areas such as Murphy Avenue, public transit, and usable public spaces. Also trash cans, since apparently that reduces littering.

19. Sustainability is a new and emerging issue in many communities. What do you think are the primary sustainability policy issues this commission will be addressing over the next few years?

Climate change is already a burgeoning catastrophe. We're going to get more bursts of heavy rain and more dry spells, we're going to get colder weather and hotter weather, we're going to get rapid cycling between weather patterns and systems. We can't do anything about the increasing level of carbon dioxide in the air and any health effects that has, but we can continue to monitor and address any specific pollution problems and to do everything we can to lower our own carbon footprint.

20. Sustainability Commissioners will need to consider social, economic and environmental issues when addressing sustainability policy issues. How does one achieve a balanced community?

I don't have a good answer to this. Ultimately, while there are some things that are obvious sustainability victories which also line up with the good of everyone (fighting pollution, better public transit, a more resilient power grid), most sustainability policy involves spending money and therefore is a budgetary drain that will reduce the available spending towards building a balanced community. We should do it anyway, because everyone must.

- 19. Sustainability is a new and emerging issue in many communities. What do you think are the primary sustainability policy issues this commission will be addressing over the next few years?
 - 1) Effects of traffic and bicycle congestion (noise, air, etc) given the growth that Sunnyvale has been seeing, both due to higher # of residences as well as more office space being leased
 - 2) Access to additional sustainability related resources like EV charging stations, parks, electric bikes, solar panels across all city buildings (new and old)
 - 3) A strategic plan to address the effects of climate change as it pertains to how our residents live in the city. For example, a set of sustainable steps to undertake to conserve natural resources like water (not just when there is a drought, should be every year) as well as steps to manage power outages, which will occur more frequently due to higher temperatures as well as great climate related events (high winds, storms etc).
 - 4) Create a Sustainability score for every resident and business owner in Sunnyvale. The more I do to be socially and environmentally responsible, the higher my score, which in turn could get me rewards like discounts to city resources or access to corporate gifts or bragging rights on the city dashboard. We tried this at Volvo, to encourage hybrid car customers to drive in EV mode more by giving them discounts to EV charging sessions.

20. Sustainability Commissioners will need to consider social, economic and environmental issues when addressing sustainability policy issues. How does one achieve a balanced community?

By making it everyone's issue and not just the city's or the sustainability board's. This is only going to work if everyone plays by the same rules and everyone contributes in their own way. Also, by having a very transparent policy and process and by over-communicating the Sustainability board's progress, every resident should have access to what's working and what is not. These policies shouldn't be considered as "nice-to-have", but "must haves" because the time to act on social, economic and environmental issues is now. And if the new Sunnyvale city hall can lead the nation in being the first Platinum LEED building, then why can't the Sustainability board lead the state in being the most engaging and forward-looking community to solve the issues of the future and leave the city better than we all found it.
