SUPPLEMENTAL FREEWAY MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into, in duplicate, this
eleventh day of July, 1967, by and
between the State of California, acting by and through the
Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, hereinafter
for convenience referred to as "the State," and the City of
Sunnyvale, hereinafter for convenience referred to as "the City,"
witnesseth:

WHEREAS, on September 8, 1959, a Freeway Agreement was
executed between the City and the State relating to the develop-
ment as a freeway, of that portion of State Highway Routes 68
(new 101) and 113 (new 237), within the limits of the City of
Sunnyvale, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of said Freeway Agreement,
the City agreed to certain adjustments in the City street system,
and for the carrying of certain streets over or under or to a
connection with the Freeway, and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have previously entered into
a Freeway Maintenance Agreement dated May 31, 1962, marked Exhibit
"A", entitled "Freeway Maintenance Agreement, IV-SC1-68-Sunv",
consisting of 3 sheets dated 1962, and

WHEREAS, said Freeway Maintenance Agreement delegates the
maintenance of Mathilda Avenue between Routes 237 and 101, and

WHEREAS, by Relinquishment No. 31398, recorded on August 29,
1966, the City received title to superseded Route 85, and

WHEREAS, that portion of superseded Route 85 covers Mathilda Avenue from Route 101 south to Homestead Road, and

WHEREAS, said relinquishment effects the division of maintenance between the State and the City, necessitating a revision in the Freeway Maintenance Agreement, and

WHEREAS, additional plan maps marked Exhibit "B", entitled "Freeway Maintenance Agreement with the City of Sunnyvale, 04-SC1-101, P.M. 45.7," consisting of 4 sheets dated May 1, 1967, have been prepared.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED:

1. That the plan maps attached hereto, marked Exhibit "B", entitled "Freeway Maintenance Agreement with the City of Sunnyvale, 04-SC1-101, P.M. 45.7," consisting of 4 sheets dated May 1, 1967, shall be added to the Exhibits of the Freeway Maintenance Agreement dated May 31, 1962, and become a part of said Agreement for all intent and purposes.

2. That, except for the addition of the plan maps marked Exhibit "B", said Freeway Maintenance Agreement dated May 31, 1962, shall remain in full force and effect, unmodified by any provision of this Agreement.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Supplemental Agreement shall be effective upon the date of its execution by the State; it being understood and agreed, however, that the execution of this Agreement shall not affect any pre-existing obligations of the City to maintain designated areas pursuant to prior written notice from the State that work in such areas, which the City has agreed to maintain pursuant to the terms of the Freeway Agreement, has been completed.






