Dear Board of Supervisors:

I am writing to express the City of Sunnyvale's support for the recommendations presented by the Office of Supportive Housing (OSH) regarding the development of Safe Parking and temporary housing on government-owned land.

The proposed approach of exploring opportunities in partnership with cities is both practical and prudent. The shared experience highlights the importance of community engagement and the need for cities to lead site selection processes with County staff support. This ensures the suitability of sites but also fosters community buy-in, which is essential for the successful implementation of Safe Parking and temporary housing projects.

Additionally, Sunnyvale would support funding for the supportive services or costs to prepare a site for occupation for these types of programs. The City of Sunnyvale places a high priority on supporting our unhoused community through our participation in the Santa Clara County Continuum of Care, our continued support of local homeless service providers, and our City Council's prioritization of unhoused study issues year after year (Policy HE-5.6). The City of Sunnyvale will be taking a Safe Parking Ordinance to our commissions and Council this Fall for consideration; we look forward to having an opportunity through the development of the 2025-2030 Community Plan to End Homelessness to engage with the County on Safe Parking or temporary housing sites and funding.
