**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SUNNYVALE DECLARING CANVASS OF RETURNS AND
RESULTS OF THE CONSOLIDATED SPECIAL MUNICIPAL
ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 3, 2020**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sunnyvale duly called and ordered held in the City on Tuesday, March 3, 2020, a Consolidated Special Municipal Election and submitted to Sunnyvale voters Measure B, proposing an amendment to Article VI of the City of Sunnyvale Charter to implement City Council elections with six districts and a mayor elected by all City voters, and related changes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California, the Registrar of Voters of the County of Santa Clara has duly canvassed the votes cast by the electors in the City of Sunnyvale upon the offices hereinafter set forth, and has supplied to the City Council the Certificate of Election Results and the final results of the votes cast, which are attached as Exhibit "A."

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER THAT:

1. The total number of votes cast in the City of Sunnyvale at the Consolidated Special Municipal Election, and the number of votes cast in each precinct for the persons and respective offices to be filled at the Consolidated Special Municipal Election, are as listed in Exhibit "A," which is incorporated herein by this reference.
2. The statement of the final results by the County of Santa Clara Registrar of Voters as shown in Exhibit "A", and the results of the votes cast at the Consolidated Special Municipal Election are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.
3. At the consolidated special election, the following ballot question proposing amendment to the Municipal Code of the City of Sunnyvale was submitted to the voters, and the number of votes cast for and against the measure is as follows:

	Shall Article VI of the City of Sunnyvale Charter be amended to establish “by-district” elections for six Council members required to be residents of a district and elected only by the voters of that district, and one Mayor who will be directly elected by all City voters; change term limits to permit service on the Council for three consecutive terms but only two as Council member or Mayor; and make other conforming amendments? 4. Measure B required approval of a majority of voters to be adopted, and because this Resolution declares that a majority of voters voting on Measure B did vote in favor of the measure, it is deemed adopted by the electors of the City of Sunnyvale. The City Attorney is directed to prepare amendments to the City Charter in accordance therewith.
5. The total number of ballots cast in the City of Sunnyvale at the consolidated Special Municipal Election was 35,458 and the total number of votes given in each precinct of the City of Sunnyvale was as set forth in the canvass by the Registrar of Voters of Santa Clara County.

6. The City Clerk of the City of Sunnyvale hereby is instructed to enter this resolution on the minutes of the City Council as a statement of the results of the March 3, 2020, Consolidated General Municipal Election.
