

Introduction of an Ordinance to Renew a Franchise Agreement for Nitrogen Distribution

Background

- Nitrogen is an inert gas used in packaging and manufacturing
- Current Franchise agreement in place with the city since 1978
- Franchise Ordinance was amended and extended over time
- Current 15-year agreement expires Dec. 31, 2025
- Air Products requested to extend the agreement for 15 years
- Current Revenue is approximately \$40K annually

Discussion

- Staff conducted a survey of rates in the area
- Rates methodologies vary between Cities
- Staff balance remaining competitive rate while maximizing revenue
- Recommended Rate consistent with Fremont and Milpitas
- Estimate annual review \$100k annually

Recommendation

Alternatives

- 1. Introduce an Ordinance awarding a fifteen-year extension to an existing franchise for the distribution of nitrogen gas
- 2. Do not introduce an Ordinance to renew the franchise agreement
- 3. Do not introduce an Ordinance and direct staff to negotiate different terms with Air Products.

Staff Recommendation

 Alternative 1 – Introduce an Ordinance awarding a fifteen-year extension to an existing franchise for the distribution of nitrogen gas
