Recommendation: Alternative 2: Do not initiate the heritage resource nomination process for several redwood trees at Sunnyvale Civic Center. The Civic Center Master Plan process already has a mechanism in place to evaluate all protected trees at the Civic Center and to evaluate potential historic resources. Any protected trees that are potentially impacted by future buildings or site features would be evaluated further with a Program Environmental Impact Report, which requires City Council approval. The Vision Statement adopted by City Council for the Civic Center already includes the preservation of trees.
