



Reduce arterial speeds to 35mph or lower on routes used by bicyclists or provide atleast a 2 foot buffer from the edge of the bike lane to the right traffic lane. I know there is state law concerning speed limits but neighboring cities somehow get around it.

Consider dooring (a car door being unexpectedly being opened and hitting a bicyclist) when placing bike lanes next to parking spaces. Note that parked cars are more dangerous for bicyclists than moving ones because of this problem. Most bike lanes in the city do not provide a buffer between parked cars and the bike lane forcing the bicyclist to ride at the traffic edge of the lane.

Remove street parking where feasible.



Sunnyvale is a diverse community with people who come from different areas of the country as well as different regions of the globe--many of them relatively new residents. It is difficult to create and maintain a sense of community under these circumstances. One way of helping to build community is by establishing a sense of shared history among our residents which will in turn create a common connection and identify.

Sunnyvale has a unique and interesting history but too few residents know anything about it. One way to preserve history is by preserving historically significant structures, and through them tell the history of the City. By participating on the Historic Preservation Commission, I hope to do my part to tell Sunnyvale's unique story and share it with its residents.

I am a lawyer by training having practiced law in both the Florida and Illinois. Sadly, all structures from the mid-20th century and earlier are at risk in Silicon Valley. The appetite for new housing is voracious and the population incredibly dense. Some of our landmarks have received the recognition that saved them from demolition—the Libby Water Tower, Joseph Hendy Ironworks, and Hangar 1 at Moffett Field. Yet, there are many more modest structures that I drive by each day that have caught my interest. Some of these are the Wittel Inn on Murphy Avenue, a wonderful example of 1930's housekeeping cottages; the mid-20th century Bank of the West Building on Mathilda Avenue with its futuristic vibe; and Vito's Pizza on Reed Avenue—the former Ice Palace where Olympian Brian Boitano once practiced. Each of these buildings tell a chapter in Sunnyvale's story.

The City should promote the properties its selects for preservation by publicizing its efforts through plagues describing their historical significance, and by partnering with local historical groups and socities to develop docent led neighborhood history walks and other living history programming. The goal should not only saving the building or site, but also sharing the building or site—and its story—with Sunnyvale's residents.

Many attributes of a site or structure should be considered when recommending preservation. The hisotrical significance of a structure or a location may be based upon events that occurred there or significant historical figures that are associated with the location. 


