



This area has many offices and is also an important connector for bicycle traffic between (1) the Bay Trail from Shoreline and the Googleplex, (2) Borregas bike bridges to Downtown Sunnyvale, and (3) Baylands where it connects to the bicycle ways towards Milpitas/Fremont as well as Downtown San Jose. The roads in this area are wide and have many car lanes, which lends itself to faster driving and makes other road users feel unsafe. All bike lanes should be protected bike lanes to shield people on bikes from distracted drivers, and keep drivers from stopping in bike lanes.
