Assembly Bill (AB) 481

Background

- September 30, 2021 Gov. Newsom signed several police reform bills into law.
- Assembly Bill 481: Military Equipment Funding, Acquisition and Use.
 - Increase transparency, accountability, oversight for the acquisition and use of military equipment.
 - Protect the public's welfare, safety, civil rights and liberties.
 - Broad definition of "military equipment" beyond equipment acquired from military surplus programs.

Assembly Bill (AB) 481

Requirements

- Inventory and develop a draft military equipment use policy by May 1, 2022
- Seek City Council approval of policy by ordinance.
- Every year thereafter, prepare an annual report.
