Study Goals

Sidewalk Gap Closure Feasibility

 Close the sidewalk gap along the east side of Poplar Ave. from El Camino Real to Rosalia Ave.

• Existing Landscaping and Property Frontages

 Minimize impacts to existing landscaping, vegetation, mailboxes, and fences along property frontages in City right-of-way

Active Transportation Plan & Vision Zero Plan

 Improve pedestrian safety and access to encourage active transportation modes.



Conceptual Alternatives

Two Alternatives

- Poplar Concept A
- Poplar Concept B


Bryant Way Gap

- City staff also evaluated closing the sidewalk gap along Bryant Way from Poplar Ave to about 160 feet east of Poplar Ave.
- Evaluation includes north and south sides of Bryant Way.




Poplar Concept A






Poplar Concept B

Coordination & Outreach

Santa Clara Unified School District

- City staff met with Peterson Middle School representatives October 2022 to present the study.
- School representatives requested to add Bryant Way sidewalk gap closure to the scope of the study.
- School representatives provided a letter of support for closing the sidewalk gaps on Poplar Ave & Bryant Way.

Impacted Residents

- In late 2022, City staff met with residents whose property frontage would be impacted by the project.
- Residents have shown support for the project and willingness to cooperate with the City.

Preliminary Cost Estimates

	Total Project Cost
Poplar Concept A	\$800,000
Poplar Concept B	\$744,000
+ Bryant (North & South)	+\$255,000
+ Bryant (South)	+\$126,000

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends Alternative 1: Accept the findings of the Poplar Avenue Sidewalk Study (DPW 21-04), approve installation of Concept A: 6-foot wide sidewalk and 4-foot wide park strip along the east side of Poplar Avenue, and approve installation of a minimum 6-foot wide sidewalk on the north and south sides of Bryant Way east of Poplar Avenue.
