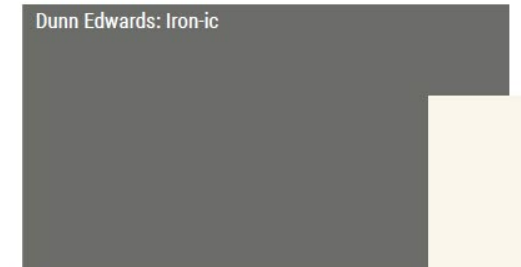

# Interior Flooring

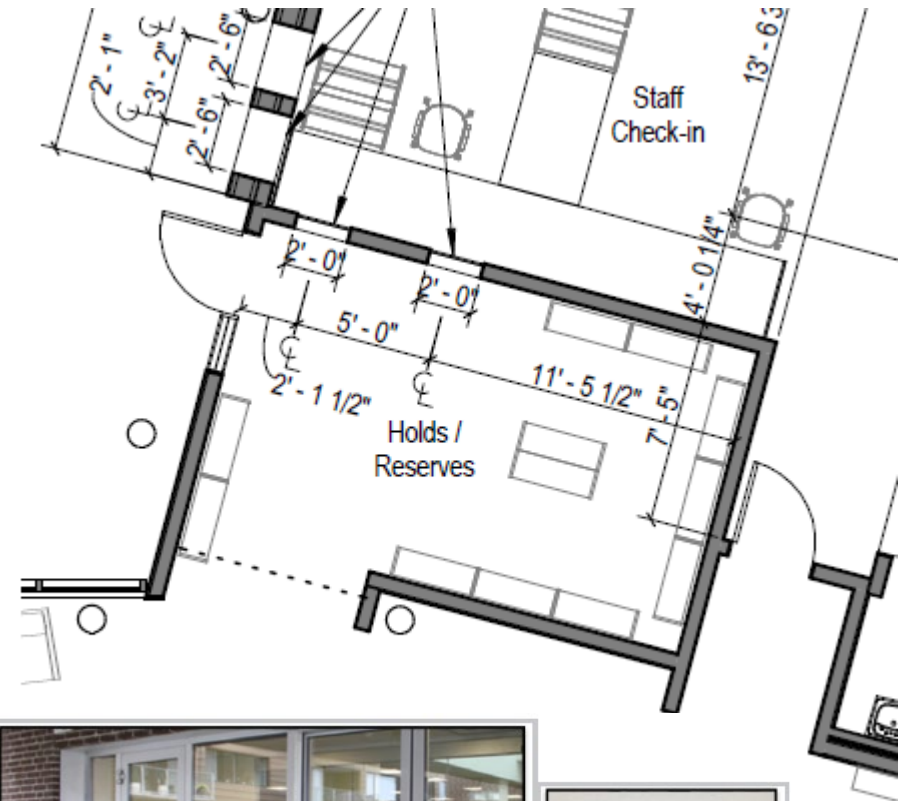


A1 Free flowing - meandering pathways - organic lines - less obvious human control

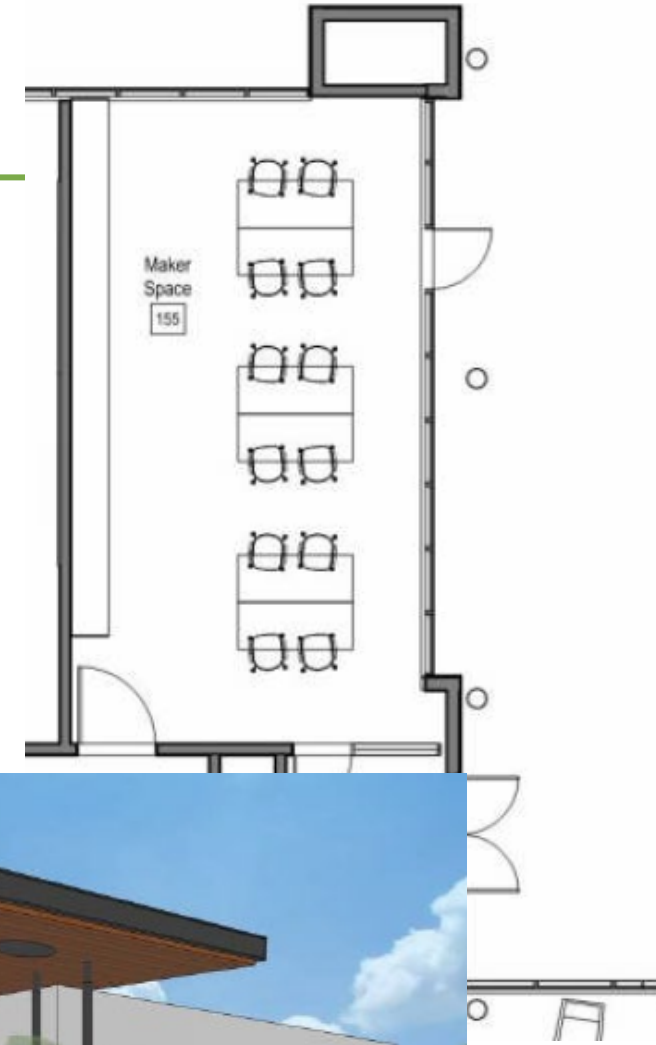
Not overtly literal but recognizable visual connection to nature - greater positive effect on occupant well-being - soothing neutral palette - stronger connection to the park outdoors

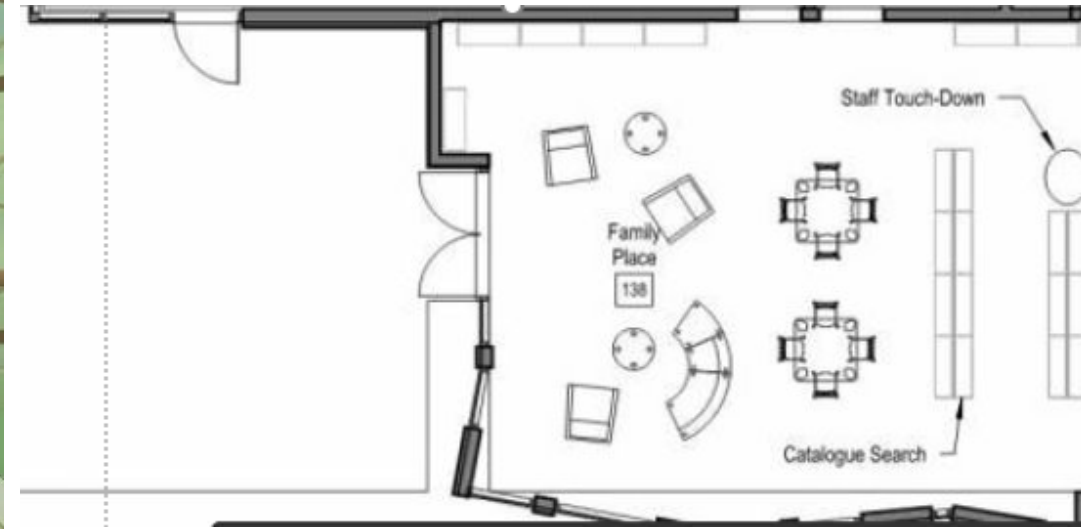
