AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE AMENDING THE PRECISE ZONING PLAN, ZONING DISTRICTS MAP, TO REZONE CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED AT 520 E. WEDDELL DRIVE FROM M-S/POA (INDUSTRIAL AND SERVICE/ PLACE OF ASSEMBLY) TO R-4/PD (HIGH DENSITY RESIDENTIAL/ PLANNED DEVELOPMENT) ZONING DISTRICT

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT OF PRECISE ZONING PLAN. The Precise Zoning Plan, Zoning Districts Map, City of Sunnyvale (Section 19.16.050 of the Sunnyvale Municipal Code) hereby is amended to re-zone a certain property located at 520 E. Weddell Drive (APN 110-14-190) from M-S/POA (Industrial and Service/ Place of Assembly) to R-4/PD (High Density Residential/ Planned Development) Zoning District. The location of the property is set forth on the scale drawing attached as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. CEQA—ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT. The environmental effects of the proposed amendment to the Precise Zoning Plan and Zoning District Map were analyzed in the East Weddell Residential Projects Environmental Impact Report (the "EIR"), SCH #2013052010. The City Council reviewed the EIR and found that it reflects the independent judgment of the City Council and its staff, and is an adequate and extensive assessment of the environmental impacts of the proposed amendment. The City Council certified the EIR as having been prepared in compliance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), (Resolution No. ___-14) made necessary findings, and adopted a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (Resolution No. ___-14). The City Council incorporates by this reference the findings contained in the EIR as to the environmental effects of the proposed amendment, together with the additional findings contained in this Resolution.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days from and after the date of its adoption.


