#### Background

# On January 15, 2015 Assembly Bill 1147 (AB 1147) went into effect.

- California Massage Therapy Council (CAMTC)
   board is reorganized
- Professional standards for massage professionals are raised
- Regulatory authority of massage establishments is returned to local governments



#### **Purpose of the Proposed Ordinance**

Protect members of the public

- Protect legitimate operators and practitioners
- Establish appropriate oversight of massage establishments



# **Massage Establishments**

# **Massage Establishments**

Existing Ordinance	New Ordinance
No current provision for home-based establishments	Home-based massage businesses considered Massage Establishments
	Owners/Operators held responsible
	Posting requirements to (a) comply with California Civil Code related to human trafficking and (b) list employed therapists



## **Massage Therapists**

<b>Existing Ordinance</b>	New Ordinance
All must be licensed  CAMTC Certification [OR]  Sunnyvale DPS Permit (in lieu)	All must be CAMTC Certified
Must carry proof of certification or permit	Must wear CAMTC identification while performing massage services
Off-premise massage practitioners subject to additional requirements (9.41.160)	Off-premise massage practitioners treated as other employed massage therapists



#### **Changes to Title 19 (Zoning)**

Home based massage businesses will be considered home occupations pursuant to Section 19.42.010 of the Zoning Code.

- May not have employees
- Vehicles visiting the premises limited to three per day
- No alterations to the home that are nonresidential in nature
- Signage must comply with Section 19.44.040
