Re: 2017 List of Potential Study Issues

Attached is a list of new CDD Study Issues that relate to the Planning Commission plus three that were deferred in 2016. Also listed for your reference are four study issues for which departments other than CDD are responsible that will require Planning Commission consideration. One of the Planning Commission sponsored Study Issues, Consider Modifications to Current Procedures Related to Timing for Release of Public Hearing Reports and Documents, was pulled from the ranking process and deemed to be operational in nature. Rather than treating it as a Study Issue, that item will be evaluated separately.

At the hearing on November 14, 2016, the Planning Commission will recommend to Council whether an item should be ranked, deferred, or dropped (or "no recommendation", if so desired). Planning Commission will then rank those items not recommended for deferral, dropping or with no recommendation. The Planning Commission's recommendations will be transmitted to the Council as input to the decisions on the potential Study Issues.

The annual City Council public hearing on potential study and budget issues for calendar year 2017 will be held on Tuesday, January 10, 2017. The City Council will rank the Study/Budget issues at the Council Workshop on Friday, February 17, 2017.
