We are writing this letter about the survey that was mailed to each property owner by the City Planner intended to independently verify the level of support. We believe that the survey was construed in a confusing manner.

The survey listed three questions  
"Do you support the application?"  
"Do you not support the application?"  
"I have no opinion".  
with each having the choice of either answering "YES" or "NO", which might have led to some confusion on how to respond to the survey. As an example, if a property owner is in support of the application was it necessary to answer ALL three questions by marking "yes" for the first answer, and "No" for the remaining? OR did it suffice to just answer the first question? No instructions were provided on how to deal with the three different questions. It is not obvious if both of our answers above would be counted in support of the application or not?

If the survey results are included in the report and/or recommendations to the Planning Commission we sincerely request to share the survey results and how the outcome was compiled.
