

## RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2016, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS INITIATIVE MEASURE M AND CITY MEASURE N, CONFIRMING THE PASSAGE OF MEASURE N AND DEFEAT OF MEASURE M AND SUCH OTHER MATTER AS PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sunnyvale ("City") duly called and ordered held in the City of Sunnyvale on Tuesday, November 8, 2016, a General Municipal Election and submitted to the voters:

- (1) Measure M proposing an initiative titled "Public Lands for Public Use Act" to modify the City's municipal code by requiring prior voter approval for any sale, lease, lease extension, lease renewal, land swap, or transfer of property owned, leased, or used by the City as a public park or community service amenity; and
- (2) Measure N proposing to modernize the City's existing utility users tax to treat telecommunication taxpayers equally regardless of technology used by updating an outdated ordinance.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California, the Registrar of Voters of the County of Santa Clara has duly canvassed the votes cast by the electors in the City of Sunnyvale upon the offices hereinafter set forth, and has supplied to the City Council the final results of the votes cast, which results are attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference; a copy of the Certification of Election Results from the County of Santa Clara Registrar of Voters is also attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE THAT:

- 1. The statement of the final results by the County of Santa Clara Registrar of Voters (as shown in Exhibit "A") and the results of the votes cast at the General Municipal Election are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.
- 2. The total numbers of votes cast in the City of Sunnyvale at the General Election and the number of votes cast in each precinct for and against the ballot measures submitted at the General Municipal Election, are as set forth in the Certification of Election Results from the County of Santa Clara Registrar of Voters, as shown in Exhibit "A."

3. At the General Election, the following measures were submitted to the voters and the number of votes cast for and against the measures are as follows:

- 5. Measure N received a majority of the votes cast and is deemed adopted by the electors of the City of Sunnyvale. The City Attorney is directed to prepare an amendment to Chapter 3.12 (Utility Users Tax) of Title 3 (Revenue and Finance) of the Sunnyvale Municipal Code in accordance therewith.
- 6. The City Clerk of the City of Sunnyvale hereby is instructed to enter this resolution on the minutes of the City Council as a statement of the results of the 2016 General Municipal Election.
