Recommendations

- Locate facility in the northwestern portion of the Park
- Avoid construction during the bird breeding season (1 February to 31 August), or implement pre-construction surveys

Benefits

- Avoids wetlands
- Avoids salt marsh harvest mouse habitat
- Avoids impacts on Congdon's Tarplant

Background

Summary of Council Direction:

Direct staff to work with Animal Assisted Happiness if they choose to provide a proposal for locating their facilities at Baylands and the County is amenable to considering this type of use at the park.

- 2010 the City and County signed a 25-year lease with a ten-year extension option.
- December 15, 2016 the City received an approval letter from the County for AAH sublease.
