

USE PERMIT/SPECIAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT JUSTIFICATIONS

One of the two following findings must be made in order to approve a Use Permit or Special Development Permit application.

The Sunnyvale Municipal code states that at least one of the following two justifications must be met before granting the Use Permit or Special Development Permit. Please provide us information on how your project meets at least one of the following criteria.

OR

2. The proposed use ensures that the general appearance of proposed structures, or the uses to be made of the property to which the application refers, will not impair either the orderly development of, or the existing uses being made of, adjacent properties as ...

The proposed additions will not change the existing use and is consistent with the development of adjacent neighborhood.

The exterior extension of the kitchen with size of 40 sf towards the rear yard is small and only one story high which will have little impact on the privacy to the rear neighbor.

The interior addition of a 3 rd bed room on the 2nd floor is within the existing building envelope and will not change the exterior appearance of the property viewing from the street.
