# Sunnyvale Theatre & Dance Studio



- 350+ shows annually (FY16/17)
- 60,000+ audience attendance annually (FY16/17)
- Up to four shows from three user groups per day
- Resident theater company –Sunnyvale Community Players (SCP)
- State-of-the-art sound system
- LED lighting system

- Weekly drop-in programs


#### Art in Private Development (AIPD)



- 64 projects completed
- 78 works of art installed within city limits



Art in Public Places (AIPP)





 Program contributed six works of art to the City's Permanent Art Collection

#### Permanent Art Collection





- Owned and maintained by the City of Sunnyvale
- 62 artworks and growing
- Artworks acquired through the Master Plan for Public Art (1983-1992), private donations and the AIPP Program

## Hands on the Arts (HOTS)







- •32<sup>nd</sup> Year
- 30 to 40 artists workshops
- More than 2,000 community members in attendance
- 700-1100 youth participants

#### Master Plan for Public Art (MPPA)

- 2012 City Council amended the Art in Private
   Development requirements, allowing in-lieu of fee
   option and recommended development of a Master
   Plan for Public Art.
- Staff working with the Cultural Planning Group to complete the plan
- Community input sessions, community surveys and stakeholder interviews.
