- Disasters are local
 - Public expects us to:
 - *Take immediate action*
 - *Marshall resources*
 - *Channel efforts*
 - *Solicit assistance*
 - Cycle - Mitigation; preparedness; response; recovery
- EOP:
 - *Assigns responsibility*
 - *Establishes lines of authority*
 - *Highlights organizational relationships*
 - *Identifies personnel*
 - *Identifies steps*
 - *Cites legal basis*
