The proposed entry porch is well designed and it helps in defining the front entrance. The additions are consistent with the architectural style of the house and immediate neighborhood. <i>Finding met</i>
2.2.2 Respect the scale, bulk and character of homes in the adjacent neighborhood.	The design, scale and bulk of the proposed addition is similar to the existing and surrounding two-story homes. The proposal maintains the plate height and the roof style. The proposed addition of the front porch, decorative elements over the second-floor windows, and the stone veneer band on the front façade will complement the character of homes in the adjacent neighborhood. <i>Finding met</i>
2.2.3 Design homes to respect their immediate neighbors	The proposed additions comply with the code requirements related to height and setbacks. The proposal is respectful of the form of the existing home and the surrounding neighborhood. All proposed windows to the second story along the side yards are either high-sill or with frosted glass to respect the privacy of adjacent neighbors. <i>Finding met</i>
2.2.4 Minimize the visual impacts of parking.	The project meets the required parking requirements. The project proposes an addition of a two-car garage to correct the existing nonconforming garage conversion. The proposed two-car garage will minimize the visual impact of parking by making two covered parking spaces available. <i>Finding Met</i>
