

During those months, I was in my best mental and physical form. After returning, I struggle to ride by bike for extended distance for fear of safety. I am interested in contributing to the City's initiatives to improve and facilitate safe walking and safe biking for individuals and families.



Ever since I was a child, I was immersed in the arts. This is thanks to my early education at Sunnyvale's own Cherry Chase Elementary. I remember these formative years spent in an art integrated curriculum fondly. In addition, my mother who is Bay Area muralist was busy painting across the city. I went to piano lessons and studied ballet with local Sunnyvale artists growing up. These formative experiences translated into my higher studies and broader career. My love for the arts was fostered in Sunnyvale. Now at age 27, I've lived in India, China and across the US only to come back to my hometown. I am looking to give back to this community that shaped the person that I am today.

In college, I did in-depth research on the political economy of arts funding. This work translated into my first job in the policy department at American for the Arts in Washington, DC. When I was serving with the Peace Corps in China I was able to plan a piano concert series and an international e-commerce and craft conference. Sunnyvale has a number of disconnections in our bike network, where cyclists are required to merge with traffic. An example of this is Sunnyvale Ave. north of the Caltrain tracks. These breaks discourage cycling. They especially discourage families from taking their children cycling, which is important in the long run, as children who cycle will eventually become adults who understand that cycling is a real transportation option.

We should be working with major employers like LinkedIn, Apple, and Google to promote employee cycling programs. Adding bike lanes--especially protected bike lanes--to facilitate safe commuting to these major employers could prove very helpful.

Borregas / Sunnyvale-Saratoga is a key area to focus on improving bicycle and pedestrian safety, as it runs from Baylands, across 101 and 237, past Bishop Elementary, past our revitalized downtown, all the way down to the Cupertino border and the old Apple Campus. One important change here would be to extend bike lane coverage on Sunnyvale north of Evelyn to Bishop Elementary, in coordination with a safe routes to school program. A bicycle pedestrian underpass at the Caltrain/Sunnyvale crossing would also be hugely valuable.

My greatest concern is with our written and oral history. The history of Sunnyvale's growth and development, how we got to where we are today, is hugely important. That history can inform our citizens and leaders when they're faced with tough questions about the future of our city, but to do that it needs to be accessible. Digitizing records and providing web resources about our city's history and heritage would be very valuable.

In terms of structures, I am concerned at the possibility of historic homes--Craftsman's and Eichlers, in particular--being replaced with so-called "McMansions"--large, expensive homes typically not in architectural harmony with their surroundings.

Lastly, there is the Old Olson Cherry Orchard near the tennis courts at Mathilda and El Camino. One of the last orchards in our city, it occupies a small site near Sunnyvale parkland. In the event that the owners should decide to sell, I would hope that the city would prioritize acquiring this land and combining it with Las Palmas Park.

6. What factors would influence your recommendation to preserve a particular building or site?

One needs to consider the aesthetic and historic value of the site. It may be cliche to say that cities are living organisms, but the metaphor is valid. Cities change constantly. Not everything can or should be preserved. So, why is the site in question interesting? What happened there? What does it say about our past? What would we lose if it were demolished or built over? Is it particularly aesthetically pleasing? The Onizuka blue cube was here for decades, but no one would seriously have considered it a candidate for historic preservation. On the other hand, the airship hangars on Moffett Field (not, of course, part of Sunnyvale, but still a valuable example) are iconic, despite not being particularly aesthetic structures. Finally, even if the site cannot be preserved, we can still include plaques and photographs to indicate its importance and past uses.





This is particularly challenging in Sunnyvale where we have extraordinary variations in wealth and poverty, racial and cultural backgrounds. Without careful planning and forethought, the natural outcome will likely be a very divided set of experiences where each person naturally follows whatever commercial interests are available for their socio-economic background. However, we have the opportunity to devise experiences that unite and lift the community as a whole.

gangs and other options. If, however, she were to find out about interesting programs at the library, positive neighborhood

youth groups or other activities, the impact on her path could be life altering.

While the above illustrates an extreme scenario of two high-school students, any recreation planning decision has the possibility to profoundly impact lives. Seemingly simple decisions about a playground can determine if a child with a disability feels empowered or excluded, whether a child learns to follow a prescribed play path or is encouraged to create their own experiences.

I recently moved to Sunnyvale from Palo Alto where I watched the evolution of that City's policy on the preservation of residences and other other buildings designed by Joseph Eichler in the 1950's thru the 1970's. The residents of Palo Alto pushed the City to view these properties through a different lens; they are not as old as some of the buildings in old Palo Alto, nor are they tied to the history of Leland Stanford and the university he created. However, these buildings are part an important chapter in the region's history and are deserving of protection. The success of this grassroots effort inspires me to apply for the City of Sunnyvale's Historic Preservation Commission.

Sunnyvale is a diverse community with people who come from different areas of the country as well as different regions of the globe. As was happening in Palo Alto, new construction is changing the character of our neighborhoods. A sense of shared history establishes a common connection among residents and helps build community. Sadly, all structures from the mid-20th century and earlier are at risk in Silicon Valley. The appetite for new housing is voracious and the population incredibly dense. Some of our landmarks have received the recognition that saved them from demolition--the Libby Water Tower, Joseph Hendy Ironworks, and Hangar 1 at Moffett Field. Yet, there are more modest structures that I drive by each day that have caught my interest. Some of these are the Wittel Inn on Murphy Avenue, a wonderful example of 1930's housekeeping cottages; a sweet set of housekeeping cottages on California Avenue where I exit from the Central Expressway; and, Vito's Pizza on Reed Avenue--the former Ice Palace where Olympian Brian Boitano once practiced. Each of these tell a chapter in Sunnyvale's story.

The City should promote the properties it selects for preservation by publicizing its efforts through plaques describing their historical significance, and by partnering with local historical societies to develop docent led neighborhood history walks and other living history programming. The goal should not only be saving the building or site, but also sharing the building or site--and its' story--with as many Sunnyvale residents as possible.

6. What factors would influence your recommendation to preserve a particular building or site?

Many attributes of a site or structure should be considered when recommending preservation. The historical significance of a structure or a location may be based upon events that occurred there or significant historical figures that are associated with the location.
