AMENDMENT: Councilmember Goldman moved an amendment to include consideration of voting systems into the motion. The motion died due to lack of a second.

MOTION: Mayor Hendricks moved and Councilmember Melton seconded the motion to approve Alternative 1 with additions: Direct staff to scope a public outreach and education plan for receiving public input on whether the Council should place a measure on the November 2020 ballot for voters to decide whether to amend the City Charter to change from at large with numbered seats to district based elections or other approaches that are tailored as pertained to the California Voting Rights Act, and return to Council by November 2018 for approval of the outreach plan which includes outreach in multiple languages and resources necessary to implement that plan; and creation of a citizens advisory committee where staff can consider the appropriate groups to be included in it.

FRIENDLY AMENDMENT: Councilmember Goldman moved an friendly amendment to include consideration of voting systems into the motion. Mayor Hendricks declined to accept the friendly amendment. The motion died due to lack of a second.
