CS Division had the largest number of active volunteers


- 59% of the City's volunteers

Becoming a City Volunteer

- View the list of current Volunteer Opportunities
- Submit one application:
 - General Volunteer Application
 - Library Volunteer Application
 - Community Services and Senior Center Application
- Staff liaison checks for minimum requirements and submits to volunteer coordinator
- Volunteer coordinator contacts the volunteer to provide further details and facilitates the candidate's process for clearance
 - Minimum age to volunteer is 13 years old
 - Individuals 18 years old and older must be fingerprinted by Public Safety and cleared with the Department of Justice
