- 20,200+ volunteer hours

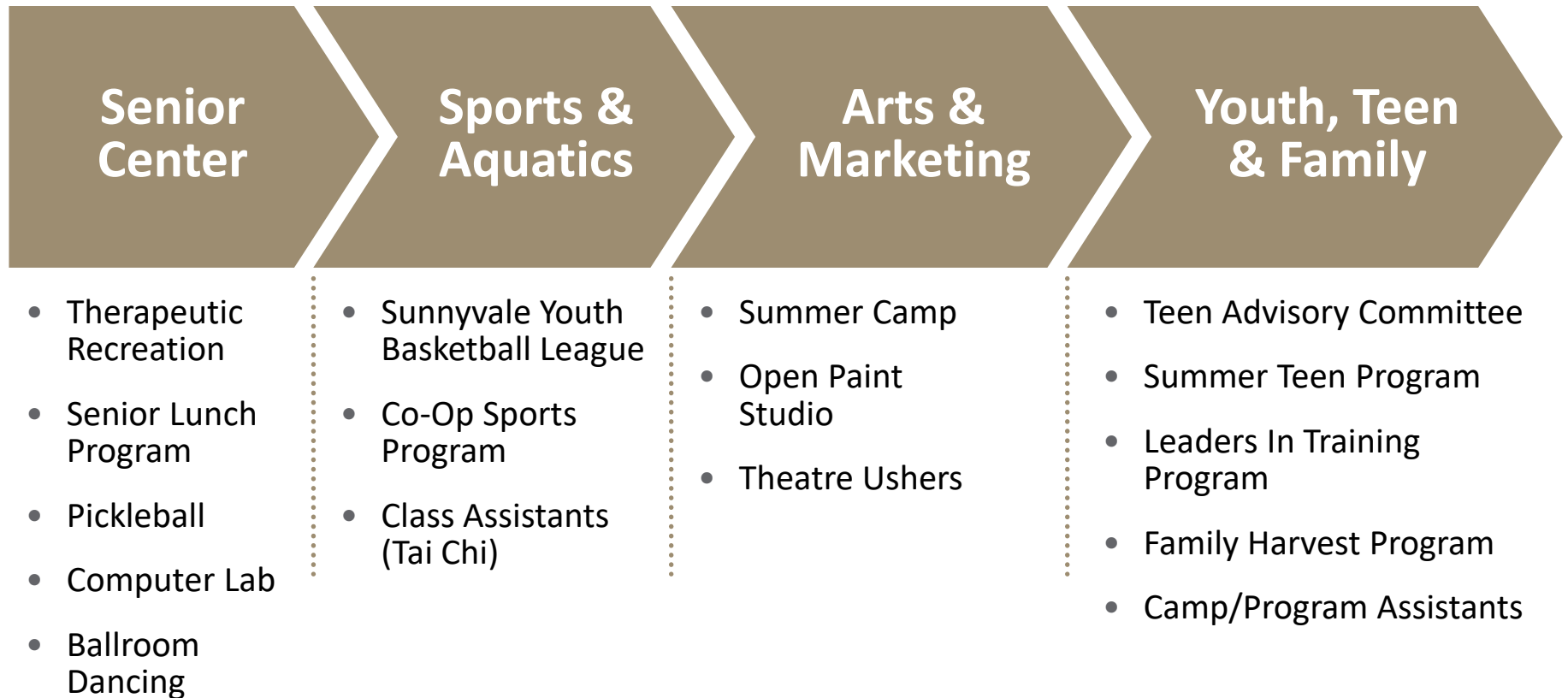
\$574,000 estimated value of volunteer service

# Becoming a City Volunteer

- View the list of current [Volunteer Opportunities](#)
- Submit one application:
  - ◆ General Volunteer Application
  - ◆ Library Volunteer Application
  - ◆ Community Services and Senior Center Application
- Staff liaison checks for minimum requirements and submits to volunteer coordinator
- Volunteer coordinator contacts the volunteer to provide further details and facilitates the candidate's process for clearance
  - ◆ Minimum age to volunteer is 13 years old
  - ◆ Individuals 18 years old and older must be fingerprinted by Public Safety and cleared with the Department of Justice
