ADDITIONAL SUPPORTIVE STATEMENTS ABOUT SUMMIT DENALI @ SAN ALESO:

- Since 2012, newly approved housing developments in Sunnyvale will bring over 5,000
 people to the community. As a result, demand for quality, neighborhood schools will
 grow in the years to come.
- Summit Denali is the only public high school to open in Sunnyvale in over 35 years.
- Once Summit Denali is in a long-term facility, it will draw more students from the surrounding neighborhood providing a walkable option for families who will live in these new homes.
- All charter schools face the same challenge finding adequate facilities. In 2000, California voters passed Proposition 39 which requires school districts to share public school facilities with charter schools if requested. Summit decided to forgo this avenue and rather than burden local school districts. Denali found its own facility that would meet the needs of the community.
- In line with the needs of Sunnyvale families, Summit is investing in the community by updating 824 San Aleso Ave. to be a brand new high school that will serve the neighborhood after opening in 2019.
