Background

Sunnyvale Green Building Program

- Original Program adopted with Moffett Park Specific Plan in 2004
 - Only applied to development within MPSP
- Expanded Citywide in 2009
- Typically amended following updates to the California Building Code
 - Last updated in 2014

Single-Family and Duplex Dwellings

New Construction, Minimum Standards

Current

- GreenPoint Rated
 Checklist with 80 pts,
 verified by Green Point
 Rater
- CALGreen Mandatory Measures

- GreenPoint Rated
 Checklist with <u>90</u> pts,
 verified by Green Point
 Rater
- CALGreen Mandatory Measures

Single-Family and Duplex Dwellings

New Construction, Voluntary Incentives

Current

- Incentive:
 - 5% increase in lot coverage
- Requirement:
 - GreenPoint Rated
 Checklist with 110 pts,
 with verification by LEED
 AP

- Incentive:
 - 5% increase in lot coverage; or
 - 5% increase in FAR or 4,000 s.f. (whichever is less) with staff-level DR
- Requirement:
 - 120 pts with Build It Green Certification; or
 - All-electric home

Single-Family or Duplex Dwelling

Additions to Existing Structures (including ADU's)

Current

- Voluntary Incentives:
 - None

- Voluntary Incentives:
 - 5% increase in lot coverage; or
 - 5% increase in FAR or 4,000 s.f. (whichever is less) with staff-level DR
- Requirements:
 - 120 pts with Build It Green Certification; or
 - All-electric home

Multi-family Dwellings

New Construction, Minimum Standards

Current

- GreenPoint Rated Checklist with 80 pts, with verification by Green Point Rater
- CALGreen Mandatory Measures

- 90 points with Build it Green Certification; and
- CALGreen Mandatory Measures; and
- Encouraged to include specific sustainable measures

Multi-family Dwellings

New Construction, Voluntary Incentives

Current

- Incentives:
 - 5' increase in height; or
 - 5% increase in lot coverage; or
 - 5% density bonus
- Requirements:
 - GreenPoint Rated
 Checklist with 110 pts,
 with verification by LEED
 AP

Proposed

Incentives: No change

- Requirements:
 - 120 pts with Build It
 Green Certification; and
 - All-electric home; and
 - One or more specific sustainable measures.



Program Recommendations: Non-Residential Development

Development Projects between 5,000 – 30,000 s.f.

New Construction, Minimum Standards

Current

- LEED Silver with verification by LEED AP
- CALGreen Mandatory Measures

- LEED <u>Gold</u> with verification by LEED AP
- CALGreen Mandatory Measures

Development Projects over 30,000 s.f.

New Construction, Minimum Standards

Current

- LEED Gold with verification by LEED AP
- CALGreen Mandatory Measures

- LEED Gold with <u>USGBC</u> <u>Certification</u>, including <u>Design Phase Credits</u> <u>reviewed</u>
- CALGreen Mandatory Measures

Development Projects Not within Moffett Park and over 5,000 s.f.

New Construction, Voluntary Incentives

Current

- Incentive:
 - 10% increase in FAR; or
 - 10' increase in height
- Requirement:
 - LEED Gold with USGBC Certification

- Incentive:
 - 10% increase in FAR; or
 - 10' increase in height
- Requirement:
 - LEED Gold with min. 75
 points and USGBC
 Certification + Design
 Phase Credits; and
 - All-electric

Development Projects within Moffett Park over 5,000 s.f.

New Construction, Volunteer Incentives

Current

- Incentives:
 - 15% increase in FAR for MP-I
 - 20% increase in FAR for MP-TOD
- Requirement:
 - LEED Gold with USGBC Certification

- Incentives:
 - No Change
- Requirement:
 - LEED Gold with min. 75
 points and USGBC
 Certification + Design
 Phase Credits; and
 - All-electric

Development Projects within Moffett Park over 5,000 s.f. – additional incentive

New Construction, Volunteer Incentives

Current

- Incentive:
 - Another 10% increase in FAR
- Requirements:
 - LEED Gold with USGBC Certification, and
 - Major Moffett Park SDP with additional green/ sustainable features

- Incentive: No change
- Requirements:
 - LEED Platinum, USGBC
 Certified + Design Phase
 Credits, or
 - Zero Energy, ILFI Certified;
 and
 - All-electric; and
 - Additional Community Benefit features.

Non-Residential Development: Major Alterations

Current

- Threshold: <10,000 s.f.
- Requirement:
 - CALGreen Mandatory Measures
- Threshold: >10,000 s.f.
- Requirement:
 - LEED Silver with verification by LEED AP
 - CALGreen Mandatory Measures

- Threshold: <u>Any size</u>
- Requirement:
 - LEED Silver with verification by LEED AP
 - CALGreen Mandatory Measures



Program Recommendations: Public Facilities

Public Facilities: New Construction

Current

- Threshold: ≤5,000 s.f.
- Requirement:
 - CALGreen Mandatory Measures
- Threshold: >5,000 s.f.
- Requirement:
 - LEED Silver with verification by LEED AP
 - CALGreen Mandatory Measures

- Threshold: ≤5,000 s.f.
- Requirement: No change

- Threshold: >5,000 s.f.
- Requirement:
 - LEED <u>Gold</u> with verification by LEED AP
 - CALGreen Mandatory Measures

Public Facilities: Major Alterations

Current

- **Threshold:** ≤10,000 s.f.
- Requirement:
 - LEED Certified with verification by LEED AP
 - CALGreen Mandatory Measures
- **Threshold:** >10,000 s.f.
- Requirement:
 - LEED Silver with verification by LEED AP
 - CALGreen Mandatory Measures

- Threshold: All
- Requirement:
 - LEED Silver with verification by LEED AP
 - CALGreen Mandatory Measures

Community Outreach Efforts

- Study Session with Sustainability Commission in September 2016
- 4 Community Outreach Meetings in August & October 2018
 - 29 attendees
 - 23 comment letters received
 - Major topics in comment letters/meetings:
 - Move towards electrification
 - Increase minimum and voluntary thresholds

Commission Hearings

- Sustainability Commission on 3/18/19
 - Recommended forwarding the staff recommendation with one modification
 - Made a separate motion to recommend that the City Council require all new construction to be all-electric, which may be considered with the future reach code discussion and building code update.
- Planning Commission on 3/25/19
 - Recommended forwarding the staff recommendation without modifications
