#### Considerations

- Preferred option of the Sunnyvale Downtown Association
- Recommended for 1 year pilot
- Existing outdoor dining permits will need to be updated to reflect changes and requirements
- City and businesses will periodically check-in to review pilot effectiveness
- Staff to come back to Council in one year for pilot evaluation and next steps
